

CURATE'S CHRONICLES – JANUARY 2024 (HAVING AN EPIPHANY)

Christmas is over - the tree is down, and the decorations are packed away, January is well and truly upon us. If you are like me, you might be feeling a tad gloomy?!

To counteract this feeling, I remind myself that we still have a good reason to celebrate and that is the season of Epiphany. This season begins after the 12 days of Christmas and stretches into February and there are places in Europe that still have their crib scenes on display, which I'm all for.

Epiphany means appearance or manifestation, so for us perhaps Epiphany isn't the end of Christmas, but an enlarging of it?

Epiphany is the part of the Christmas Story that marks the arrival in Bethlehem of "The Wise Men" or the "Magi". They were outsiders, travellers from a foreign land, and we might wonder about their suitability to play any part in the story. However, they recognised the significance of the coming of Christ, whilst King Herod could not. He saw a threat and, filled with jealousy, was bent on destroying what he could not accept. They saw a child who would change the world forever.

This time last year I was sailing in the Hebrides, it was utterly freezing but it was magnificently beautiful, and the sky was like nothing I've seen anywhere before. I felt my heart and mind expand in awe at the beauty of God's gift.

This past year has been a tumultuous one with the Ukraine-Russia and Gaza-Israel conflicts at the fore. As I look forward to 2024, I wonder what sort of year it will be? God-willing I will be Priested in June and I fervently hope that I can look forward to the year with an enlarged vision and with an open heart and mind. I pray that I'll spot the 'daily Epiphanies' in which God is revealed in the unlikely and the unexpected.

There is a wonderful hymn that comes to mind:

There's a wideness in God's mercy, like the wideness of the sea. There's a kindness in God's justice, which is more than liberty.

There is welcome for the sinner, and more graces for the good. There is mercy with the Saviour, there is healing in his blood.

But we make God's love too narrow by false limits of our own, and we magnify its strictness with a zeal God will not own.

For the love of God is broader than the measures of the mind, and the heart of the Eternal is most wonderfully kind.

If our love were but more simple, we should rest upon God's word, and our lives would be illumined by the presence of our Lord.




