

Two good pieces of news to report to you all.

## **Roof Repairs**

Most of you will be aware that the repairs to both the North and South Aisle roofs were completed just before Christmas 2016.

This was a huge relief to the PCC and resulted in a reduction to zero of the newspapers used to mop up frequent leaks through the temporary covering.

Prior to the repairs, Church funds were totally inadequate to cover repair costs.

However, our knowledge of and subsequent successful application for a grant from 'The Listed Places of Worship - Roof Repair Fund' enabled the work to be carried out. For this lifeline the PCC are extremely grateful. Our thanks also go to others, who made donations towards the total cost and to those who offered words of encouragement during the project.

Also, but not least, to our MP, Matthew Hancock, who with his local colleagues campaigned to have the theft of Lead included in grant funding from 'The National Heritage Memorial Fund'.

### Sound System

A comprehensive Sound System was successfully installed, tested and commissioned in January this year. Technically this includes an Induction Loop to assist those with hearing challenges, throat and handheld microphones (wireless), a central control system together with high level speakers and a CD Player.

There are also connections for other audio devices and for Power Point audio linkup. Once again the PCC are extremely grateful to those who donated monies towards this project. In particular The Broxted Estate, Brenda Holdgate, E-Bound Alarm Systems and to those who supported various fund raising events.

# HUNDON PARISH COUNCIL Village Matters

Hundon Parish Meeting was held on Wednesday 15<sup>th</sup> February 2016.

### **Police Aware**

It has been reported that theft from garden sheds has increased considerably recently. Shed alarms can be bought at a reasonable cost and residents of Hundon are urged to become more safety conscious and vigilant.

# **Speeding**

- TVAS machines –Our County Councillor has agreed to donate £2500 towards the cost of the TVAS machine, which we anticipate will cost around £5000 for the machines and all the paraphernalia required i.e. brackets, posts etc. We will keep you informed of the progress
- Wheelie Bin Speed Stickers- These have now arrived and are being delivered with the next edition of the Hundon Herald to North Street, Church Street & Clare Road. More stickers are to be ordered for Lower Road; there will be two stickers per household.

### Street Markings & potholes

Road Markings at the end of Church Street /North Street which were reported to the Council are to be reinstated. The Surfacing Team have been reminded and they have been asked to add a 'give way' triangle marking, to highlight the junction better.

The 'give way' triangle on Mares Hill is on a single-track road less than 4.5m wide so the correct placement for this marking is in the centre of the carriageway and we have been informed that the existing markings are correct.

The potholes in North Street near Farmerie Road have been reported to Suffolk County Council.

### **Hundon Tidy-up**

Paul Rook has very kindly cleaned our Hundon Sign and also the Memorial. Quotes are to be secured for work to repaint our village telephone box which is in need of some care and attention





People who bought BT8500/CallGuardian telephones are finding them complex and expensive to use. You will presumably already be on the Telephone Preference Service. Here are two further ideas:

### **BT Call Protect**

If you already have a BT line rental and pay for 1571 (£2.25/month) you can add for free, BT Call Protect. This filters your calls against the BT central Blacklist and you can add unwanted callers to your personal Blacklist after you have received a call and without having to note and enter the nuisance number. Details from www.bt.com/callprotect

### Who called Me?

There are multiple websites where you can look up other people's experiences of a particular caller (number).

I use http://who-called.co.uk

Scammers can be identified as such, area codes looked up and you can add, without the rigmarole of registering, your own experience of a caller.

# WALKING HADRIAN'S WALL AND FUNDRAISING FOR THE DNRC

In May this year I will be walking 70 miles along Hadrian's Wall with my sister and will be fundraising for the new and currently under construction Defence and National Rehabilitation Centre (DNRC).

Military rehabilitation is currently undertaken at Headley Court in Surrey which originally opened in 1947 to treat RAF aircrew. Today it provides high grade treatment for all 3 of the armed services and all ranks, dealing with injuries which, in many cases, would have been fatal a decade ago.

Headley Court is a small site and the ability to modernise has become limited. A study, funded by the Duke of Westminster, looked at whether a 21st century version of Headley Court was needed.

It was established that not only was a new military establishment needed but a site was required that would be large enough to allow the development of national facilities. It was also recognised that the expertise that exists within defence medicine could be shared for the benefit of the nation as a whole. This would allow the rehabilitation of those injured and disabled in civilian life.

Headley Court will relocate to the Stanford Hall Estate in Nottinghamshire with the new facility opening in 2018.

I am supporting the DNRC charity because my Mum and Sister were members of Queen Alexandra's Royal Army Nursing Corps and my Sister spent over thirty years in the army with her husband John. A bricks and mortar charity suited my aim of contributing to something that would stand the test of time and one where the benefits were immediate.

I chose Hadrian's Wall as I was born in Newcastle and love the north of England and because I wanted to prove to myself that even with a combined age of 136!! we could still meet a physical and mental challenge. I think you are never too old to have an adventure.

Please support me with encouragement as I train for the walk around Hundon and support this worthwhile cause. We never know when we might need such a facility ourselves.
