APPEAL FOR VOLUNTEERS


Our village shop is a community shop which relies almost entirely on volunteers to keep it open.

If you can spare some time to help keep the shop running (or know somebody who might) then please speak to Karen on 786223, or call into the shop for more information.






CONGRATULATIONS

UPDATE ON THE PROPOSED REFURBISHMENT OF THE WAR MEMORIAL

Earlier this year a campaign was launched to refurbish the War Memorial and at the same time add the names of four who, while listed on the Roll of Honour in the church, were missing from the memorial, which as you know honours those brave men from Hundon who were killed in the First and Second World Wars.

The memorial was originally erected shortly after the end of World War One and would have been largely funded by public subscription. Originally it was positioned at the lower end of North Street where it remained for over 50 years until it was moved to its current position in the churchyard.

Quotations for the work were obtained and local funeral directors and stonemasons, Paintins who provided a comprehensive schedule of work and submitted the lowest quote. Unlike some others they would remove the memorial to their workshop in Linton where the detailed work could be carried out under ideal conditions. The Revd Canon Stuart Mitchell and the church were content with this removal plan. In order to provide an accurate figure Paintins had surveyed the memorial and commented that the state of the memorial which is covered in "grime and lichen" was largely due to its location where it is permanently shaded by the trees. As it would be removed to be refurbished etc. it occurred to us that perhaps it would make sense to return it to where, as when it was originally erected, it would be in a more prominent position.

We attended the Parish Council meeting in July together with the Revd Canon Stuart Mitchell who had previously been consulted regarding the refurbishment and also with regards to the proposal to re-site it. Both the Parish Council and Borough and County Councillor Mary Evans support this since, apart from the problems highlighted by Paintins, surely in this Centenary Year for those honoured on the Memorial to be brought out of the shadows to where light perpetual can shine upon them should be everyone's wish. However, we were advised by the Revd Canon Mitchell that before work could commence it would be necessary to apply to the Diocese for a "faculty" whereby a formal application detailing the work is submitted (together with a fee). The application was made in time for it to be heard at the monthly meeting of the "DAC" on September 7th and although approval was given in principle it was then necessary for it to be displayed for a 28 day Public Consultation after which it then goes to the Chancellor for final approval and then to the Registrar. This process took a total of nearly 7 weeks- to almost the end of October - and unfortunately Paintins, who had been on "standby" decided that they could not guarantee completion for Remembrance Sunday which as you will appreciate has been the aim of the campaign in this Centenary Year.

For reasons best known to themselves the Diocese, while agreeing that the much-needed refurbishment be carried out have stated categorically that the memorial must be returned to its current position. We are puzzled by the DAC's unwillingness to accept that there has been a lot of support in the village for this proposal; however, it wouldn't be the first time that the Church has not respected the wishes of the people of Hundon. Since it seems that for whatever reason they appear to have laid claim to this important, if modest monument, maybe they should pay to have it restored to its former glory and let it be sited in a more prominent position in our village.

FROM THE REVD CANON STUART MITCHELL AT THE VICARAGE IN CLARE

Rural Dean of the Deanery of Clare

January 2019. Happy New Year?

Greetings to all across the Deanery at the beginning of this New Year. Back at the beginning of December, in Clare, the 40th anniversary of the Community Carols was peppered with love and joy and hope. Young and old, light hearted and deeply serious, musical offerings that were across the range of new and thought provoking (thank you Priory) not so old given a youthful twist (thanks SVCS), leaders doing what leaders should – taking the lead (thank you Guiders). For a moment – well ninety minutes, all that political stuff was left to the speculative reporters desperate to fill endless hours of news coverage. I know we need to know about such things and yet there is so much opportunity for individual opinion, none of which can do a thing about anything except express an opinion.




