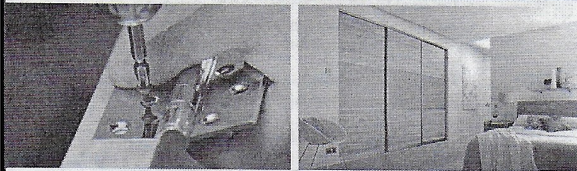

PARISH LETTER – FEBRUARY 2019

The chilly, dull days of January are behind us, and we are into the month of February. The naked trees still stand silhouetted against the sky and the ground is peppered with budding bulbs just waiting to burst into colour. February can be a time when despite some dark and gloomy days, we can nevertheless look forward with hope and anticipation to the season of spring, when the days lengthen and earth begins to take on the warmth of the early sunshine. How that can cheer our hearts! I remember when I was a child, around about this time of year my mother would gather all her cleaning implements to begin the annual 'spring clean' - a moment I dreaded, knowing I would be roped in to help!

I wonder where that tradition comes from? Perhaps it's because in winter, with dark nights and cold weather, we tend to be less active – it's so much nicer to curl up in the warm! Then, as the weather improves and the days grow longer, we emerge from our hibernation and start to prepare for the better weather. Many National Trust houses follow a ritual of 'putting the house to bed for the winter' - that's mostly because the houses need extra care during the damper, colder months, but also because time needs to be spent on the maintenance and conservation of the old buildings, and a thorough spring clean is essential in order to put them into order and generally keep them ship-shape.

Nowadays I understand why spring cleaning is so beneficial - not just in practical ways like this, however important, but in spiritual and emotional ways as well. And that's something we can do for our own spiritual lives as we prepare for the better weather ahead. How can we clear out the cobwebs of the past and sweep clean our attitudes and behaviour? Maybe by looking at areas of our lives that haven't been as they should be - where we have let not only ourselves and other people down, but God too. Perhaps we could be kinder, more forgiving, more tolerant, more encouraging and less judgemental. Maybe we have negative thoughts that serve only to push us away from God; maybe there is someone who is lonely and who we have avoided in the past, allowing the cobwebs and dust to settle instead. It can be so easy to leave God out of our lives – so perhaps now is the time to think about including God in more of what we do, what we say, and how we behave.

Taking stock of our lives, behaviour and attitudes is healthy, and clearing out the debris to make room for a cleaner and better way of living can only be a positive. As we head towards spring, let's find ways of cleaning up our lives to enable our faith and our relationship with God to be strengthened, refreshed and sustained. What a positive effect that will have - not only on our own lives but the lives of others too!

Some of us went on a fascinating trip to southern Spain where we visited famous sherry bodegas, ate lots of fish and drank far too much Spanish wine. The year ended with a Christmas dinner for 35 of us.

Our revered Chairman, chef and wine expert, the genial Chris Burford has led the Club to its present success but now we have grown to our present size it is too much to expect one person to carry all the burden of running it. Don't worry though – we're not going to spend the evening gassing about constitutions. The Club's aim is to learn about, appreciate and enjoy wine and Roger Merry will quickly get on with presenting an evening of Portuguese regional wines. The programme for the next few months will include presentations by Chris and other members and from some excellent wine merchants (always good for buying some wine at a discount). Chris and the new committee are also aiming to add a wider range of events to the programme, such as visits to vineyards in our region and social events where we can enjoy good food, wine and company. 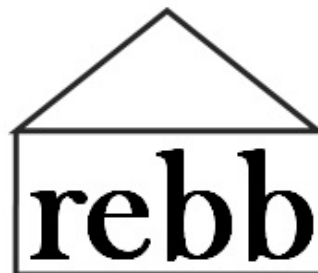

CHOLANGIOPHINOMA

FEBRUARY IS CHOLANGIOPHINOMA MONTH
 WEDNESDAY, FEBRUARY 13TH, IS WORLD
 CHOLANGIOPHINOMA DAY

Cholangiocarcinoma (Bile Duct Cancer) is a rare aggressive insidious cancer that so often goes undetected until diagnosed at Stage 4, when the chances of survival are almost nil and from being fit and able sufferers can succumb in a matter of months or weeks.

Unless you are involved at the coalface with this specific disease it is difficult to understand how it operates. It has a character of its own and family and friends have difficulty coming to terms with this aspect and have a tendency to couple it with the more popular cancers - breast, prostate, lung etc.

The only definite cause of cholangiocarcinoma has been linked with eating raw fresh water fish and vegetables washed in river water in a certain rural area of Thailand where over 20,000 people die from this cancer each year.

The fish consume the liver fluke and the parasite burrows into the liver and manifests itself 20 to 40 years later as bile duct cancer. There are no obvious symptoms, but visitors to Thailand should take care and mention to their doctor if they feel ill in later life that they have travelled to Thailand and Asia. Vietnam Veterans in the USA are now falling victim to this cancer.

There are successful survival stories, but unfortunately this underfunded and under researched disease has the final say in most cases. A Cheshire mother of three, aged under 12 at the time of her diagnosis over three years ago, was given three weeks to live, but a surgeon at the Queen Elizabeth II Hospital, Birmingham, was prepared to take a calculated chance by doing a liver resection.

This lady is still alive today. She has raised over £35,000 (excluding Gift Aid) for AMMF (UK's only cholangiocarcinoma charity) - www.ammf.org.uk - by completing the Three Peaks Challenge walking across hot coals, climbing Mount Kilimanjaro a year ago, and organising other fundraising events. Her next venture begins on February 14th when she and her supporters cycle 450 km from Vietnam to Cambodia.

PROGRESS ON THE REFURBISHMENT AND PROPOSED RELOCATION OF THE WAR MEMORIAL

In seeking to restore our war memorial the War Memorials Trust (WMT) was consulted. This was established for the protection and conservation of the thousands of memorials that were erected almost 100years ago. Over this period many, including our own have suffered neglect and it was because of the Centenary of the end of the First World War last year that the importance of maintaining these worthy tributes was highlighted.

We have been advised that the sorry state of our memorial is due in no small part to its current location in the churchyard. It was moved from its original location between the entrance to Farmerie Road and the bus shelter around 50 years ago. In seeking the advice of the WMT concerning the proposed relocation to a more prominent position in the village we were told that "where possible a war memorial should be preserved in its original location", and whilst to date we have not been able to establish why or when it was moved, it would be helpful to have a photo or even a picture of it where it was originally erected. In the meantime whilst the Diocese are prepared to allow its removal for the purposes of refurbishment and the important addition of missing names they stated that it must be returned to the churchyard. We remain optimistic that in view of the WMT's advice and the declared support of our Parochial Church Council common sense will prevail. So if you or a relative might have any evidence of its original location we would appreciate it very much if you could get in touch!!!!
