

#### LETTER FOR THE PARISH MAGAZINE

Then God said, "Let us make humankind in our image, according to our likeness; and let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the birds of the air, and over the cattle, and over all the wild animals of the earth, and over every creeping thing that creeps upon the earth." (Genesis 1.26)

These words from the Old Testament book of Genesis lie very heavily on me, and possibly on many other people too. As I write this, the news has been full of devastating facts and figures about the impact human beings have had, and are having, on our world, and the ecological crisis that faces us all. Now we have been informed that around one million species, including plants and animals, are threatened with extinction within decades - possibly during our lifetime, and certainly during our children's and grandchildren's lifetime. This makes for difficult and extremely uncomfortable reading, coupled with a sense of sheer impotency. How have we ended up in such a mess, and what on earth can be done to halt this?

According to research, plastic pollution has increased ten times since the early 1980s, and I can well believe this. I recall a few years ago travelling by ship between Singapore and India, and being aghast at the plastic waste floating alongside, for miles and miles and for days and days, as we made the journey to Chennai. It was truly dreadful. We dump millions of tonnes of toxic waste into the seas, and our insatiable appetite for cheap food, clothing and other items fuel the fire that seems to be out of control. Coral reefs have halved; there is pressure on land where crops are grown, deforestation, and wetlands that have been ravaged even more than the forests. Biodiversity is in decline – in short, we are simply plundering the resources of both land and sea, to such an extent that one wonders if there is any going back.

When God handed human beings the keys to His creation, He did so in the hope and trust we would treasure His world, and that we would tend and care for it as He tends and cares for us. The words from Genesis indicate that God made us to be reflections of Him, because He made us in His likeness. If we are to be true reflections of our creator God, then we should have some of His characteristics as well – including loving the world and all that He created. If we are to love our neighbour as Jesus taught us, then that extends to creation. Harm that and you harm your neighbour, especially the world's poor, onto whom the threat of climate change falls more heavily.

Thank God many of us are very importantly 'doing our bit', by recycling, cutting down on waste – yes, apparently we waste one-third of all our food; making informed consumer choices and more - but if world leaders aren't behind this, then our efforts are just a drop in the ocean. World leaders need to take this absolutely seriously in terms of what the scientists call "transformative change" that will shift us away from the situation we are in towards one that will help us rebuild a viable and sustainable planet. It must be a joint, cohesive and worldwide effort if it is to work at all. Let us pray that sense will prevail, and that worldwide action to halt our destructive impact will happen – and soon.

As custodians of this planet, we would do well to remember the following words from Psalm 26.1 :

"The earth is the LORD's and all that is in it, the world, and those who live in it."



Please will shop users note the opening hours of the shop and post office. The shop is open at 8.00am during the week and closes at 5.00pm. The post office is only available until 1.00pm though. Saturday is a bit different...shop opens at 8.00am but closes at 1.00pm. Sunday is different again! We open at 10.00am and close at 12.00pm.

Please will folk realise that just because the volunteers are there doesn't mean they are ready to open. There is much to be done and volunteers get there early to sort and check the papers...and with all the inserts that need to put into the papers (especially on Sunday) that takes some considerable time.

Then we need to check the fridges and freezers, monitor the shelves to make sure no produce is past its sell by date or make price reductions where we can. We then need to warm up the photocopier ready for your use and make sure the coffee machine is filled and ready.

#### **BROXTED SOLAR COMMUNITY FUND FOR HUNDON**

This was established following the completion of the solar farm in 2014. To date the Fund has awarded a total of £45,500, benefitting the Primary School, Pre-School and various clubs and organisations. We invite applications for this year and will welcome any that can be shown to bring material benefit to make our village an even better place in which to live and enjoy!

#### **APPLICATIONS FOR FUNDING - 2019**

The main features of the Community Fund are summarised: -

 $\bullet$  This year the total amount awarded will be £10,500. This will include a direct annual payment of £1,500 to Hundon School.

• The balance of £9,000 will be awarded to organisations or groups within Hundon. To receive an award from the Community Fund, an application must make a material change or create material benefit for the Community in and around Hundon, and may include revenue items as well as capital payments.

• The minimum award through the Community Fund will be £1,000 as any applicant must demonstrate 'material change' or 'material benefit' for the Community i.e. not narrowly focused or small in size or scope.

• The Community Fund is run by the Community Fund Group who will meet to discuss the merits of each application to determine whether or not they qualify for funding and if so how much will be awarded. At any one time the Group will consist of four members:

- The Chairman or Representative of the Parish Council currently Geoff Spooner
- The Chairman or Representative of the Village Hall Committee.
- One other representative of the Hundon Community with wide knowledge and experience of it currently David Rowlinson who was Parish Council Chairman when the proposal for Broxted Solar was presented at a meeting which was also attended by Dorothy Whittaker who was Hundon's Borough Councillor at the time.
- A representative of Navigator Land LLP, the owners of Broxted Estate (and hence landlords of Broxted Solar) - the first such representative being Charles Ryder. David Rowlinson acts as Chairman of the Community Fund Group and Charles Ryder/ Navigator Land LLP administers it.

If your club or Organisation has a project requiring funding and which meets the above criteria, submit details of what any award will be used for and where it involves the purchase of equipment or services should include more than one quote. Please note that all applications must be for projects which require £1,000 or more and which will be completed within 1 year of receipt of the award.

#### Applications should be emailed to Charles Ryder at charles@gbfco.com by 30th June.

During the ensuing two weeks, the Community Fund Group will consider the applications seeking, where necessary, further information. The Group will then make recommendations to Broxted Solar as to which applications should be awarded funding and payments are anticipated to be made by the end of August. Depending on the total sum requested from all applications, some which qualify may not receive an award this year, but such projects can apply again next year.

The Community Fund Group looks forward to receiving applications in the coming weeks. We very much hope that Broxted Solar's Community Fund will continue to be of great benefit to the Community of Hundon over the coming years.






#### **NEIGHBOURHOOD WATCH** - Tip for June

An easy and low cost way to discourage shed or garage burglars is to fix one or two 110+dB 'rape alarm' to the rafters, away from the entrance door, and connect the activation pin by string to a hook on the inside of the door. Around £5 each from online retailers, the interior noise will encourage thieves to leave promptly before someone comes to investigate. In the rafters they should find it difficult to replace the activation pin(s) quickly.
