Your village shop is fully focused on maintaining business as usual in these strange times. We are however mindful that we need to ensure that the small space is as safe as possible for our staff, volunteers and customers alike. We are all now realising the importance of social distancing as a key behaviour in fighting the spread of this virus.

As the shop becomes busier it is difficult to maintain social distancing in the space available. The committee have therefore decided that it would be right to ask customers to limit themselves to no more than three customers in the shop and post office at any one time.

We hope that our customers will respect this decision and realise that this will help us to keep serving you. For our part we will commit to serving customers as quickly as possible to minimise the amount of time that you are waiting outside. This will inevitably mean that at busy times there may be less opportunity for the normal social chats that are such an important part of a community shop, however unusual times call for all of us to adjust our normal ways of life.

We are now receiving an increasing number of phone calls asking for us to put items aside for later collection. We are really sorry but this is not something that we are able to do.

We are enormously grateful to our staff, Karen and Megan and to all of our volunteers, regulars and new, who are keeping the shop and post office open during this difficult time.

For those volunteers who are unable to come to the shop at the moment, we are thinking of you and hope that this thing doesn't go on too long and that we shall see you soon.

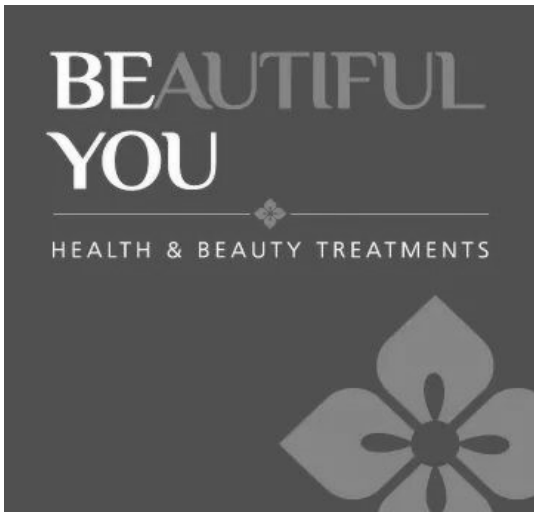

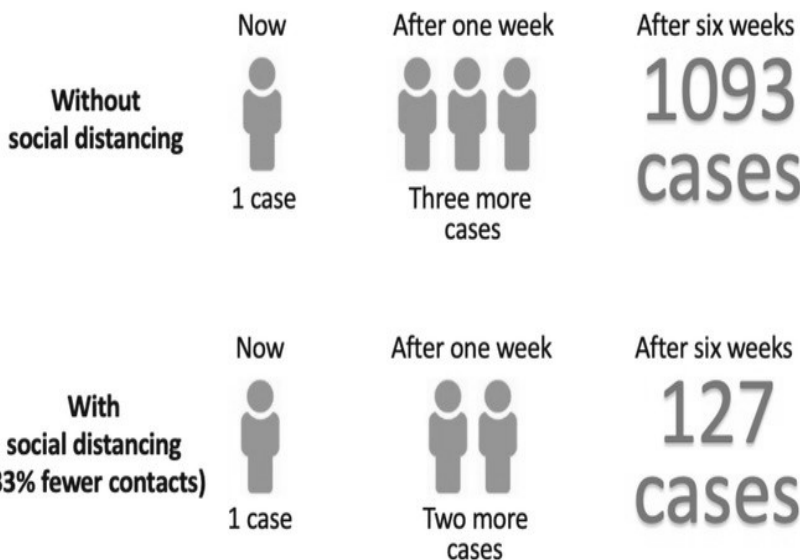

### FROM COUNCILLOR MARY EVANS

With schools closing it is likely this will only add to the anxiety and worry that many children will be feeling towards the Coronavirus outbreak. Equally parents will also be concerned about the best way to help their children understand the changes they are experiencing and on a practical level how best to plan schooling at home. #### • Suffolk Public Health: Keeping well and looking after your mental health.

Following the latest government guidance, many people in Suffolk will be self-isolating and/or working from home. While these measures are necessary, they will mean a significant change of routine and can create stress and feelings of anxiety which is why it is important to look after your mental wellbeing in the coming weeks.

The five ways to wellbeing is a really useful framework, with practical ideas to support improved mental health. Here are five tips for staying mentally well:

#### 1. **Connect with others**

Take time to call a friend or family member. It's important to stay in touch with others however you do it, and sometimes simply talking about how you feel can make a big difference. If you have a friend or neighbour who may need support or a listening ear, spare some time to talk to them.

2. **Be active** Being physically active can have a real benefit to your mental health. If you are not self-isolating, try building in a walk or other exercise during the day. If you are indoors, take regular screen breaks and stretch at least once every hour.

3. **Learn** Take the opportunity to think about learning a new skill or pick up something you have enjoyed doing before. Always wanted to read that book, or learn that language? Now is the time. More classes and courses are also available online now than ever before.

4. **Take notice** It's all too easy to become immersed in the constant, and ever-changing media coverage surrounding coronavirus (COVID-19). Take a break from watching, listening or reading news stories and use the time for the things you enjoy. Techniques such as mindfulness can be helpful.

5. **Give** Giving your time and energy to others is extremely important, never more so than now, and can pay dividends for your mental wellbeing. Whether it's looking out for and helping a neighbour, or registering to volunteer to offer support in your community, there is plenty you can do. The '**Home, but not alone**' campaign is one such example, run in partnership between the East Anglian Daily Times, Suffolk County Council, Community Action Suffolk, Suffolk Community Foundation and the Suffolk Association of Local Councils.

## LETTER FROM THE CURATE – APRIL 2020

Over the last few weeks of Lent, Peter and I have been doing our best to spend more time in prayer and study, following especially The Church of England's 'Live Lent – Care for God's Creation' 40-day challenge, as well as our own Bishops' Environmental Lent Challenge. As you can imagine, it's been pretty full on over these last 40 days! We've signed up to leaving the car behind and walking more, swapping our single-use plastic shower gel and handwash bottles for bars of soap, turning the heating down a notch or two, and even swapping Google for Ecosia – a search engine that tots up our online searches, and then plants trees around the world, funded by its advertising revenue. What a brilliant idea! At the time of writing, almost 87 million trees across the world have been planted – all of this is helping the environment by creating rainforests, initiating conservation projects and empowering communities across the globe. Why not look them up ([www.ecosia.org](http://www.ecosia.org)) and do the same?

Yes, this year's period of Lent has really taught me how careless, wasteful and thoughtless I have been towards God's creation. But on the plus side, it has been in many ways a fruitful time, because I have started to change my attitudes and behaviour. And now we are coming into the season of Easter, another fruitful time; a time of warmth and sunshine (and less rain, we hope!), flowers and plants budding and blooming, birds nesting - all combining to bring the promise of new life, following what has been a very long, wet and gloomy autumn and winter. For many people, spring is their favourite season. How appropriate that Easter follows on the heels of winter, and just like spring, Easter too heralds new life. Out of the darkness of winter comes the light of spring, and out of the darkness of Christ's death on the cross, and the empty tomb, comes hope – hope in the resurrection, and hope that death is not the end, but the beginning.

For the disciples, the picture on that first Easter morning must have been truly depressing because Jesus was their hope - they had believed he would be the one who would save them and Israel from the tyranny of Roman rule and yet he had been crucified and their hopes were dashed. On Easter morning when Mary Magdalene and Mary the mother of James went to prepare his body for burial, they discovered that the stone at the entrance of the tomb where Jesus had been laid had been rolled away and the tomb was empty. Later we are told of Jesus' resurrection and how he appeared to many people during those days he spent before his final ascension.

The season of Easter provides us with hope, hope in the knowledge that without Easter there would be no faith, no Christian message and no gospel. If the tomb had not been found to be empty and if those early Christians had not witnessed the risen Lord walking with and alongside them, what kind of world would be living in now I wonder? Easter offers us the hope that one day we will all be drawn to Jesus when he returns and that the Easter message shines light from out of the darkness of winter and springs eternal.

## HUNDON OIL SYNDICATE

Hundon Oil Syndicate has been operating for many years and has enabled many villagers to buy oil cheaper than they could if they were ordering as individuals. By buying in bulk the syndicate can usually get a significant reduction (2p – 4p per litre) on the normal price each month. It is particularly beneficial to those with smaller tanks, who can only order less than 700 litres, thus having to pay the higher price. Indeed last month's price was only 39p per litre for all syndicate members who placed an order.

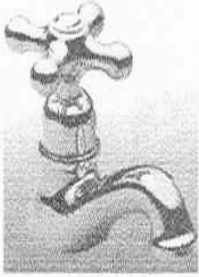
