ESTATE CHARITY THOMAS ROGERON/RELIEF IN NEED CHARITY 2020 REPORT

<u>Trustees:</u> Messrs. Davis, Impey (Chair) and McLardy; Rev Mitchell (part of year); Mesdames Morse and Turner; Miss Upson (clerk).

<u>Farmland</u>: All Rogeron farmland is being rented with income continuing to be stable. That being rented to a local business has been cleared and fenced, resulting in improved access and tidiness.

Allotments: By the end of the year there were approximately 44 allotments, of a variety of sizes, some of which have had no rent paid on them as it's the first year of the tenant taking over their plot, with many being garden extensions. The Hundon Allotments Tenants' Association was formed and their Committee has taken over the dayto-day running of the allotments. One of their aims is to help make the allotments cost neutral for the Trust within 3 years, as the allotment income does not reflect the recent capital expenditure on improvements, nor does it come anywhere near covering the annual running costs, which has implications for the amount of grants that can be given to parishioners. The HATA has, so far, received £2,200 in external grants and is currently looking at other forms of funding, with advice from Community Action Suffolk. 2 new ventures are well on the way, namely an orchard and a wildflower meadow. Many thanks go to all the volunteers who have helped with these, and especially to Liz Hickes and Fiona Gould for their hard work in setting these projects up. Trees and hedges have been tidied up or removed, depending on their condition. The many rubbish heaps have generally been cleared; from the beginning of 2018 allotment holders have been responsible for disposing of any waste from "their" allotments. Mr. Basham has done a sterling job of keeping the grass tidy and the footpaths close mown. The bank at the southern end of the field has been left, for the most part, to encourage wildlife. The Trustees are extremely grateful to Mr. Davis for the terrific work he has done on the allotment area (and his goodwill) and to Mr. Smith (the Trust's Land Agent) for his excellent advice, support and patience.

<u>Hundon Educational Foundation:</u> This received a grant of £3,750 from Rogerons.

PCC: The PCC received a grant of £2,500 from the Rogeron Charity. Maintenance of the church clock continues to be paid for (as part of the Charity's statute).

Other grants from the "main" trust: 2 local organisations received grants to help ensure their viability, so that members are able to enjoy improved access to leisure and social facilities. The Charity also gives financial support towards the costs of running the Post Office.

RIN: The Relief in Need Charity (Hundon Trust Fund) received £1,250, also from the Trust. Grants of approximately £1,000 were distributed. These included funding to help members of local organisations enjoy improved access to leisure and social facilities and also grants to help parishioners within their homes, with difficulties caused by the pandemic, with their disability and medical needs and to gain qualifications.

Parishioners are invited to apply, at any time, for grants from the Hundon Relief in Need Fund. These may be for individuals who reside in Hundon or Hundon organisations. The subcommittee of the Trustees consults on a regular basis, enabling applications for smaller requests to be discussed quickly. Larger grants, requiring a full meeting of the Trustees, are discussed twice a year (generally March and November).

Grants can be made for such things as

- the supply of tools or equipment to aid or improve employment potential
- the provision of funds for developing leisure or educational skills
- extending opportunities or resources for local organisations
- the provision of facilities for the physically or mentally disabled
- payments to assist in the meeting of utility bills (in extreme cases)
- payments to relieve sickness or infirmity
- help in paying travelling expenses for those attending hospital as out-patients or those visiting in-patients
- providing help for those who are carers
- providing grants to any who are suffering from the effects of the pandemic

This is not an exhaustive list – we consider all types of requests! However, we are not allowed to give grants for anything which should be paid for by the state (such as various benefits).

Please apply in writing, giving as much detail as possible. Please explain who the grant is for, how much you are requesting, why you are requesting it, how or what the grant will be used for etc.

Please note we will need receipts for any equipment you may buy or any services you employ.





UPDATE ON THE ALLOTMENT FIELD

Allotments

HATA consulted with allotment holders and as a result have agreed a rent increase and a new Tenancy Agreement. As of this month we have 44 paid allotments compared to 22 at this time last year and we thank all the allotment holders for their support and (mostly!) paying on time!

Dog walkers

We are entering the busiest time of the allotment year – lots of seeds being planted and established. We would therefore be very grateful if dog owners could keep their dogs under control and, most importantly, **off the allotments.** With thanks in advance.

Paths

Many thanks to the volunteers who are mowing paths around the allotment field, especially to those who have created a new path all the way round the bottom of the wildflower meadow.

Housing

There was much consternation recently, when a surveyor was seen on the field. When questioned, he said he was doing a pre-building application survey. This was followed by the publication by West Suffolk Council of the comments from the consultation on their Strategic Housing assessment. In amongst the many responses from villagers expressing their unhappiness with the idea of the allotment field being built on, was a submission from the Land Agent who advises the Rogeron Trust, expressing great support for a housing development. We hope this was his own opinion, rather than him representing the views of the current trustees. HATA will continue to work as constructively as possible with the Rogeron Trust. We aim to gain their permission to take over the management of the whole field, solving their cost issues, and optimising the benefits of the field for the community and wildlife. And thereby to reduce the likelihood of planning permission being given for housing.

Wildflower Meadow

Nearly 25 volunteers managed to avoid the hail whilst sowing wild flower seeds and plants to improve the species richness of the meadow and bank. Thanks to them and the seed and plant donors and particularly to John Christophers, who has driven and co-ordinated the work on the meadow. You will start to see new notice boards (thanks, Simon!) with information about the different habitats around the field and plants and animals you may see. Eventually we hope to have a full nature trail.





From Suffolk Police:

E-SCOOTERS

Although you can legally buy an e-scooter in the UK, you cannot currently ride it on a public road, cycle lane or pavement. The only place it can be used is on private land.

Drivers or riders seen to commit offences will be issued with Traffic Offence Reports (TORs) and face a fine, points on their licence or even court action.

E-scooters are treated as motor vehicles by the Department for Transport and are subject to the same legal requirement as other vehicles.

If caught riding an e-scooter in a public place, fines you could receive include:

- a fixed penalty notice for no insurance, with a £300 fine and six penalty points
- •a fixed penalty notice for no driving licence, up to £100 fine and three to six penalty points

Other offences which might result in penalties (including arrest) include: riding on the footpath; using a mobile phone; riding through red lights; and drink/drug driving.

THE RECTOR'S RAMBLINGS: LIVING OUR LIVES TO THE FULLEST – MAY 2021

Dear Friends

I am writing this the day after we received the news of the death of HRH Prince Philip, and the news that his funeral, like so many others in the past year will be considerably smaller than we would have wanted or expected. Perhaps it is a good reminder that in death we are all equal, and all of us, whether a Prince or Pauper, each must make that last final journey on our own.

In fact Easter remains on our hearts and minds all the way through to Pentecost on the 23rd May when we then give thanks for the gift of the Holy Spirit and is considered to be 'The Birthday of the Church' the point when the disciples and first followers of Jesus began to spread out across the world proclaiming the Good News that with Christ's resurrection, death had been beaten, and that our end isn't really the end after all, and we are therefore able to live fully all that days that are given to us.

May God bless you, your families, and your neighbours, and may all our endings be new beginnings.
