#### **HUNDON POST OFFICE - Three Years**

It doesn't seem three years since we fought to save our Village Post Office at a time when many others were closing. Megan has done a great job since taking on the role in serving our village along with Rachel, her current deputy. We have been particularly lucky during the Covid Lockdown to continue to have a working PO and shop here in the village – for some it has been a lifeline. On behalf of, I'm sure, everyone in the village and beyond I would like to say a big Thank You to them both and also to everyone who has worked to keep the Village Shop stocked and open in these difficult times.

Three years ago, when we worked to save our PO a number of village organisations and individuals agreed to contribute to a village subsidy fund, called Friends of Hundon Post Office (FOHPO), to ensure our Post Mistress receives a living wage for the services she supplies to the village and surrounding area. Indeed, without the fund we were told by Post Office Ltd (POL), in no uncertain terms, that our PO would have been closed. POL do not pay minimum wage to Post Masters/ Mistresses as the say the job is contracted and it relies on commission, which in a PO our size is hard to achieve. I am sure I speak for everyone in the village in saying THANK YOU to the FOHPOs for their financial contribution, as without them we would not have a PO. Indeed, there are now many customers from Kedington, Barnardiston and Clare who prefer to use our PO. The FOHPO fund has now been running successfully for nearly three years and we need to keep it going if our PO is to survive.

We are about to rebuild the fund for next year, which starts again on 1st August. Jane Tabram (who helps me manage the fund) and I will be contacting previous years' contributors in the next few weeks to see whether they wish to continue but we already know a few have been lost over time. To ensure our PO keeps open and Megan and Rachel receive a living wage for the excellent service they give us, we ask you all to consider whether you are willing to help. If you are please contact either me (786489) or Jane (786501) and we will explain how the fund operates. The names of contributing individuals are known only to Jane and myself and are not shared among the donor group or publicised.

**West Suffolk Local Plan -** A working group has been established to monitor and research information regarding the West Suffolk Local Plan, and to comment at the next consultation.

#### Independent Living in Suffolk

An initiative started in December 2020 to support vulnerable people to stay in their own homes.

Enquiries will be assessed by Suffolk County Council and West Suffolk will support with the application process and provide resident with a list of local contractors to complete any required work.

Between December 2020 and March 2021 the scheme has paid out more than £700,000 in grants to more than a 100 people, helping with adaptions from a simple grab rail to building extensions.

The Scheme has been awarded a further £1.5m in West Suffolk from the Government's Better Care Fund.

#### THE RECTOR'S RAMBLINGS: "A REPAIR SHOP IN EVERY COMMUNITY" - JULY 2021

#### Dear Friends

One of TV's most unlikely hits in recent years has been "The Repair Shop". For those of you unfamiliar with the concept behind the show, which now attracts audiences of 6.7 million, is, on the face of it, a recipe for very dull TV: People bring their dilapidated old possessions and heirlooms to a barn, where a group of experts restore them. Then the owners come and get them. But there is, of course, much more to it than that.

The reason behind the show's success is that almost every item brought into the repair shop has its own very special, and often very moving, story to tell. Recently I watched an episode where the team were restoring a clock set into the side of a beautiful wooden ship with metal sails. The clock had been given as a gift by a grandfather to his grandson when he was boy. Now, grown up and with a son of his own, the grandson returned to the barn for the big reveal.

The clock's owner was deaf and communicated through sign language. His son interpreted as his father expressed his emotion at being reunited with the clock, now restored to its former glory. He said that he could suddenly see his grandfather more clearly in his mind, and that seeing the clock as it was when he had received it so many years ago made him feel like he had been reunited with his grandfather who died when he was just 10 years old.

We are taught, as Christians, to have a cautious relationship with material objects. The Bible teaches us not to place greater importance on material things than God; it warns us of the dangers of covetousness which leads to an insatiable desire for more and more. Indeed, those who are called to live a life of Christian devotion as monks or nuns are required to take a vow of poverty in which they give up their personal possessions and any sense of ownership, sharing all they have with the community.

So how do we square this teaching with the very real and often very emotional relationship that many of us have with at least some of our possessions? Can we enjoy our valued possessions and still be faithful Christians? The answer is clearly yes. The key to all of this is simple: it's about our hearts. Do we live for our wealth and possessions, or do we

live to use them for the glory of God? If Jesus came to you today and said, "I have great plans for you. Come, sell everything you have and follow Me" would you be able to part ways with your things? This is the test to see if you make possessions an idol or not.

Back to that barn and those expert craftsmen and women. What the world really needs is an equivalent barn where broken <u>people</u> can turn up and share openly and honestly the stories behind how we came to be broken and to acknowledge our own part in that story; a place where, having shared the story, we can then ask to be carefully, lovingly, painstakingly restored to our former glory. Imagine if <u>we</u> had the opportunity to be repaired, restored, re-created by our master craftsman creator, lovingly held in his hands as he removes all the dirt and stains, cracks and damage of our lives, restoring us to his original vision for us.

Well, the good news is that such a barn does exist. In fact, there is one in almost every village, town and city in the country. Churches are the repair shops where <u>we</u> can go to be repaired, renewed, and restored by God our Creator.

If we are moved by the restoration of a clock, imagine the emotion and power of seeing human beings transformed, forgiven, and restored. Now that is a show I'd love to watch!

#### FROM POLICE CONNECT

#### **SUMMER SECURITY**

As we finally get to enjoy some warm sunny days, we naturally tend to have windows and doors open more, spend more time in the garden and take time out to enjoy the stunning Suffolk countryside.

Please take every opportunity to ensure that criminals are not able to spoil your day by following a few simple steps:

- Always lock your external doors, even when you are at home.
- Check the doors and windows are secure before leaving the house or at night, especially doors like French doors that may not have been used for months. Don't assume another member of the household has done it.
- Don't leave keys in the locks or within reach or sight of the door or window. Make sure you have a fire plan so everyone in the house can leave quickly in the event of an emergency.
- Windows should be left secure when a room is unoccupied, even if you are still in the house.
- Never leave a door or window insecure to allow a pet or family member access.
- Never leave car keys within reach or sight of the doors or windows.
- Lock cycles in a secure shed or garage. Fit a secure ground anchor and lock them to that too.
- Always lock tools away after working in the garden to prevent them being used to force entry.
- Ensure your rear garden is secure and lock gates.

#### **CATALYTIC CONVERTER THEFTS**

Police are appealing for information and urging vigilance after three thefts of catalytic converters from vehicles on Tuesday 15 June, where in one incident a member of public was injured after disturbing the offenders.

This incident occurred at approximately 11:55pm in School Road, Kedington.

Four males were seen removing a catalytic converter from a Honda CRV, parked on the road, before getting into their vehicle – believed to be a dark-coloured Audi A3.

The offenders were challenged by a member of public, a man aged in his 50s, who attempted to stop them, but the front passenger opened his window and threw an unknown liquid in the man's face causing reddening to his eye and blurred vision.

The suspects then reversed towards the man before driving away.

The man was taken to hospital for treatment but his injuries were not serious and he has since been discharged.

Witnesses, or anyone with information, are urged to

contact Suffolk Police quoting reference 31923/21.

Further incidents were also reported in Beccles on Tuesday 15th June.

At some point between 9:45am and 11:45am, a Suzuki Jimny had its cat converter stolen whilst parked at the Tesco carpark in George Westwood Way (reference 31967/21).

Another theft of a cat converter from a Toyota Avensis was reported to have taken place between 10:45am and 1pm whilst parked at the Beccles Tennis Club in Common Lane (reference 31958/21).

Officers are continuing their investigations and are exploring links between the incidents reported.

Members of the public are urged not to approach offenders if they see a theft in progress, for their own safety, but to instead call police on 999.

Witnesses or anyone with any information about these incidents, or who saw any suspicious vehicles at the times stated, should contact Suffolk Police via

In an emergency always call 999.

Owners of vehicles can follow these tips:

- Keep private vehicles in a well-secured garage where possible, and if no garage is available, in a well-lit public area.
- Park vehicles in such a way as to make access to the catalytic converter difficult or parallel with another vehicle if you own one.
- Keep commercial vehicles in a locked building or compound.
- If possible, use alarms, lighting and CCTV to deter thieves

#### FROM SUFFOLK TRADING STANDARDS

Scam emails have been sent impersonating the NHS in which they invite you to apply for a Covid vaccine passport - this is a scam!

One email had the subject title "We are happy to introduce Digital Coronavirus Passports" . The contents of the email can be read in the attached photograph.

Clicking on the "Get Digital Passport" link takes you to a convincing but fake NHS website that asks for personal and payment details. (For a "process fee"). The website has since been taken down.

Remember, your vaccination status is obtained FREE through the NHS App, NHS website or via phoning the NHS on 119.

# A gardeners guide to... Bird Nesting Season



season runs from March to August - but some birds nest earlier/later



Nests are often well hidden, so you might not know they are there



Birds may be nesting in your trees, shrubs, ivy, hedges, nest boxes, under eaves and on the roof



All wild birds, their nests & eggs are protected by law - this includes gulls, pigeons & crows



Do not cut back hedges, trees and other vegetation during nesting season - this risks disturbing nests



Trim hedges once a year in winter if needed - this gives wildlife the chance to eat any berries
