
#### FROM THE BRITISH HORSE SOCIETY

Getting out and about in your local area, or further afield, may mean you'll encounter horses, for example, when crossing a public right of way with horses in the field or accessing a multi-use path that runs alongside an equine paddock.

Recently, there have been increasing reports on social media, of horses being seriously injured, made extremely ill and in some cases having died because members of the public have fed the horses, <u>put grass cuttings into their field</u> or because of their direct actions, such as not closing a gate.

Although it may seem harmless your kindness may kill! It is important not to feed horses because:







Any type of food, grass cuttings or any other plants can make horses extremely ill or even kill them.



Fighting between horses could break out and cause an injury.



Always take your litter home



Keep your dog on a lead and bag and bin your dog's mess



Give horses lots of space and avoid coming between mothers and their young





Right of Way

Leave gates and property as you find them

If you see a horse in distress, alert the nearest farm / yard or check for a sign with owner's details on

Keep to the right of way

This survey does not necessarily mean that Hundon will get new housing development, instead it helps us to understand our local housing provision and needs as well as helping to inform our responses to future West Suffolk Plan consultations and potential developers.

The Parish Council will publish a summary report when the survey has been completed and the results analysed.

The Parish Council recognise all the advantages, disadvantages and concerns about future development that have been identified in the 2010 Parish Plan and more recent submissions to the West Suffolk Plan process, and these will be represented in future.

As with any housing development proposals the Parish needs will be considered alongside those of the wider communities of Suffolk, and if housing is to be provided the 'mix' of property types and sizes may be informed by this survey.

Establishing future needs for housing is not an exact science as needs can be varied and change over time. You might, for example, either now or in the future be looking to downsize to somewhere easier to manage, or perhaps move into your own house, or to upsize to start a family. There may be a 'hidden need' for people living outside the village with a connection to Hundon that would like to return if the right types of housing were available. The survey will also look at whether there is need for more affordable housing for current residents or people with a local connection to Hundon.

If you have any questions regarding the Housing Needs Survey or if you need an additional Survey Questionnaire, please contact the Parish Council at the email address above and spare copies will also be held at the village shop. This is your village, and it is important that you have your say so please take the time to complete the survey.


## Mindfulness Quote of the month

"The greatest weapon against stress is our ability to choose one thought over another"

William James

A definition of stress is - the body's response to physical, mental, or emotional pressure. Stress causes chemical changes in the body that can raise blood pressure, heart rate, and blood sugar levels. It may also lead to feelings of frustration, anxiety, anger, or depression.

The Stress container – developed by MHFA England
Helpful strategies – tap at the bottom of the triangle lets the stress out
Unhelpful strategies – tap flowing into the container can become overwhelmed/blocked



## What does your stress container look like?

- Grab a pen and paper it's time to draw your stress container. It can be triangle, it can be a big fat ol' bucket or it can even be a wine bottle whatever works for you, it's your container.
- Think through what stresses are currently present within your life... I imagine at this time you've probably already whispered to yourself: "my paper's not big enough for that". Take some time to do this and note down the stresses that are floating around in your container at the moment.
- Once you have done this, have a good think about what behaviours, practices or habits you have in your life and on which side of the container you would place them: 'helpful coping strategies' or 'unhelpful coping strategies'.
- Remember, with some behaviours or habits it can be a fine tipping point. For example, a glass of wine on
  Friday evening to unwind is very different to 2 bottles of wine to forget. Be honest with yourself while you do this it is important to be able to pinpoint those behaviours that either help you to or prevent you from reducing your
  stress levels.
- And lastly, once you have decorated your sheet with all your coping strategies, have a think about how you could
  make more time for those helpful ones that nourish your wellbeing, and where you could reduce those that are
  unhelpful. You could call this your Stress Management Plan.

#### Calming Pranayama (breath control) for Dealing with Stress

Slowing down and bringing calm to your breathing, is a proven and recognised way to deal with stress.

- Place your hands against your tummy and sit up straight in a comfortable position
- Draw your focus of attention to a deep, slow inhale and a releasing, long exhale
- Maybe the breath is in your chest at the start... Don't force anything, but observe as you begin to become calm, the breath feels deeper into the tummy.
- Notice your hands against your tummy, the soft rise and fall as the breath enters and leaves the body.
- You may want to repeat the mantra "I am breathing in... I am breathing out..."
- Feel your shoulders begin to relax down...

Jaw relaxes...

Calm restored

#### **Dietary Tips for reducing the symptoms of stress**

- Cut down on stimulants like tea & coffee, try *chamomile or lavender tea* instead, these natural herbs have relaxing and calming effects on the body.
- But, if you need that caffeine kick-start, you might like to try macha green tea, it's rich in an amino acid (L-Theanine) which has powerful stress-relieving properties and gives a more natural boost to the metabolism.
- Research shows that dark chocolate is great for enhancing mood and reducing stress (at last something you actually like that is good for you!). Melt some dark chocolate into a warm milk of your choice at bedtime for a relaxing night's sleep.

Whilst not seeking to replicate such, it will be great to archive life as it happens in Hundon today for the future.

The detail collected will be deposited within the Suffolk Record Office at Bury St Edmunds and be available for future generations.

#### CONCUSSION

(Follow up to article last month)

After a relatively mild response to the initial cricket ball shock, unfortunately the delayed shock and concussion stage was far worse for me – truly horrible in fact.

The MAIN SYMPTOMS, which may emerge days or weeks after the initial injury and take months to dissipate completely are:

- 1. Overwhelming weariness.
- 2. Severe headaches
- 3. Difficulty sleeping
- 4. Fogginess in the head
- 5. Feeling sluggish, hazy and or down.
- 6. Bothered by right lights and loud noises
- 7. Irritability uncontrollable involuntary
- 8. Tremors of fingers mostly.

So again as in shock listen to your body but in this second phase the messages are not nearly so clear and feeling like doing something does not mean you should or could do something. If in doubt, don't do it is my current mantra, i.e. slowly does it. Do less than you think you can both physically and mentally. If one does too much the headaches etc return with interest and recovery is delayed.

#### HOW TO HELP THE PATIENT:

Being kind and compassionate is enough. A little kindness and sympathy goes a long way to assist recovery. No one knows how it feels to have concussion unless they have experienced it themselves. Get well soon or similar cards are a great positive boost. A blank stare is no use to anyone, in fact is horribly negative.

This condition could last for 2-3 months. Now I am quietly optimistic that I will return to normal health without much pain or discomfort. My present level of concussion is now relieved with painkillers, never have I been such a pill junkie!
