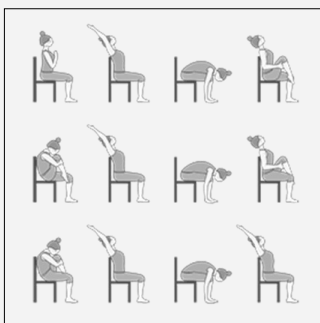

Applications

Please apply by email and include your bank sort code, account number and the exact account name. Then any grant will be transferred directly into your bank and you will be informed by email. This will save us all handling cheques and is secure PROVIDED you are careful to give accurate sort codes, account numbers and the exact account name as it is difficult or impossible to recover monies sent to the wrong place.

To be considered for a grant, you must:

Be under the age of 25 or making an application in respect of a person under 25.

Reside within the Parish of Hundon.

Please apply by email giving the following information:

Name and address of student.

Age of student.

Your sort code and account number and the exact account name.

Details of your application.

Due to restricted funds the trustees cannot normally make grants for routine travelling expenses.

General Data Protection Regulations Your details will be recorded on the Foundation's records for audit purposes but your bank details will be deleted from our records once any payment has been made. So, if you have made an application in the past you will need to supply your bank details again.

HUNDON VILLAGE SHOP AND POST OFFICE

It is definitely getting chillier in the mornings and evenings as Autumn well and truly kicks in. With gas and electricity prices spiralling those of us lucky enough to have open fires will probably make more use of them than ever. Winter fuels will again be available at your shop very soon.

You are probably seeing lots of out of stocks at the supermarkets at the moment and an increasing number of substitutions or products not available on your online shopping as a combination of factors are giving the big retailers real problems in fully supplying their stores. At the moment our wholesaler is holding up quite well so if there are things that you can't get elsewhere there is a good chance you will find an equivalent product here in the village.

Shop opening hours

In March 2019 when the pandemic started the shop committee had to reluctantly make the decision to reduce our opening hours to the current 8am to 1pm. This was because so many of our volunteers were unable to continue due to health reasons and the need to self-isolate at that time. As life appears to now be on a more normal footing, we would like to open the shop once again on weekday afternoons. For this to be possible we are completely reliant on there being enough volunteers to staff the shop for these additional hours. Karen is in the process of contacting all volunteers that we have listed to see who would be able to do what and when. Inevitably a number of former valued volunteers have decided, for various very understandable reasons, that after such a long break they are not able to resume their volunteer roles.

So, to get the shop open again in the afternoons we will need volunteers who are able to offer a regular weekly two-hour shift from either 1pm to 3pm or 3pm to 5pm.

Village Matters

- The overgrown footpath from Church Street to Valley Wash has been reported to Highways.
- The flooding issues around the village and the fallen bank at Valley Wash following the heavy rain has been reported to Highways.
- The Parish Council is liaising with Cllr B Bennett (SCC) to arrange a visit from Highways to discuss ongoing issues.
- The Trig Point near the junction of Chimney Street and Mary Lane is to be reinstated.
- The Parish Council are awaiting approval for new grit bins for Hall Road and Steeplechase.

Community Chest 2022-2023

Community Chest funding round for 2022-2023 is now open.

Community Chest funding supports voluntary and community groups who make a contribution to improving the quality of life for people in West Suffolk.

Funded activities must help deliver the Families and Communities Approach and Families and Communities Strategy and eligibility criteria apply. The minimum amount that can be applied for is £1,000. This funding can be for

Update from SCC – Cllr B Bennett

Protection for Suffolk's Blue Badge Holders.

Enforcement days have taken place, aimed at protecting genuine Blue Badge Holders.

Blue Badge offences come under the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 which makes it an offence for a badge to be used for parking without the badge holder present and covers fake badges. Certain offences can also constitute fraud and cases can be prosecuted in the Magistrates, resulting in a maximum £1000 fine.

Easing of restrictions when visiting Suffolk's Recycling Centres

From Monday 16th August restrictions for Recycling Centres eased.

Suffolk Fire and Rescue Service adds four new enhanced appliances to its fleet, fitted with solar panels

Suffolk Fire and Rescue Service has unveiled state-of-the-art rescue vehicles and equipment to equip firefighters with the latest technology for rescues. Four new "enhanced rescue tenders" will be based at Bury St Edmunds, Lowestoft, Newmarket and Princes Street (Ipswich), giving cover across the county and strengthening the emergency response across Suffolk's communities. The new equipment and vehicles are also the latest innovations in green technology, supporting Suffolk County Council's climate emergency declaration and ambitions to be net zero by 2030. The fire appliances are the first in Suffolk to be fitted with solar panels, have more fuel-efficient engines and also carry battery powered hydraulic rescue equipment.

Annual Safeguarding report praised at cabinet meeting

The Annual Safeguarding report has been praised at a cabinet meeting this week. The report for the first time has taken "whole life" approach to safeguarding from children through to adulthood.

The report summaries the activity undertaken over the past year to safeguard children and adults in Suffolk and focuses on the impact that the Covid-19 pandemic and accompanying lockdowns have had on the service. This report also informs plans to ensure the safety and wellbeing of adults and children in Suffolk as we emerge from the pandemic.

Parents teach their children to be polite, by saying "please" and "thank you." These are basic expectations of a well brought up child. Yet as adults we sometimes forget to be thankful too. A reminder perhaps, that our own faith journeys need to be like little children.

As 'children of God' we need to remember two simple lessons; give thanks always, and give thanks in all situations. (Ephesians 5:20, Psalm 34:1)

That's a good start but I believe that God longs for us to go far beyond mere head knowledge or theory, and begin living lives which make such practice a routine part of our on-going experience of him.

Saying "thank you" to God in particular, can make such a difference. We give thanks to God not just to be polite, but to appreciate that he is our provider. This avoids taking him for granted, gives him his rightful place, and makes us more and more aware of his involvement in every situation. It also helps us to view our lives with gratitude rather than being preoccupied with those things that aren't right.

So, with the thought of putting thanks into practice, I commend to you the "Thanksgiving Jar Challenge". I want to encourage every household to set up a Jar of Thanksgiving! This could be a simple way to practise 'giving thanks' daily and then occasionally review all that you have been given.

Take a jam jar, coffee jar, or Kilner jar, whatever works. Clean it out and remove the label, if required. Then cut paper strips of coloured paper – the nice stuff - be imaginative!

Keep the paper strips by the jar and every time you think of something new to say thank you for, write it on the paper, fold or roll it up, and pop it in. Keep the jar in a prominent place and perhaps weekly, monthly, or when you need encouragement, take out the strips and remind yourself of God's blessings to you.

With Remembrance Sunday just around the corner, you might like to begin with something big, with thanks for those who served and died in the pursuit of a lasting peace and our freedom, and then perhaps for your own parents, grandparents and for their sacrifices for you. Or if you or other members of the family have recently received COVID vaccinations or any other treatment you might want to give thanks for our Doctors, Nurses, Scientists, Carers indeed our NHS.

You will I am certain be blown away by God's goodness in both the big and little things!

Doing this will, I hope, also make your prayer life more varied, and your experience of the Lord much more colourful, as you slowly build up more and more things to be thankful for.

I give thanks for all of you and for the community in which I am fortunate to live and serve.

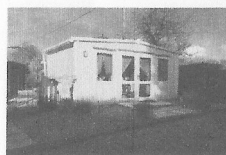

HUNDON ALLOTMENT FIELD UPDATE

A very busy month for allotment holders – harvesting in full swing and starting to tidy up for the winter, or trying to get late crops in like garlic and Christmas potatoes. In addition, the wildflower meadow has been mown.

HATA AGM

There was a good attendance at the AGM in the village hall – allotment holders and some interested members of the Hundon community. There was a review of activities and achievements this year – including the fact that we have identified 54 different species of flowering plant on the meadow already. The Treasurer gave an update on our financial situation which is very sound.

The priorities for the coming year were explained:

- Renovating Jimmy's Shed so it can act as a hub for HATA equipment and field activities
- Planting of additional orchard and specimen trees
- Seating
- Continuing to enrich the plant diversity of the wildflower meadow

The proposed draft for a new HATA Constitution, to reflect our expanded responsibilities for the whole allotment field, was accepted unanimously.

The previous committee were thanked for their efforts over the past year, as were all the volunteers who have done such a fabulous job keeping paths mown and the field looking good. We are also grateful for those who donated money or supported our fund-raising.

Calling all dog walkers

During the AGM discussions, the continuing problem with dog poo on the field paths and the allotments themselves was raised. We recognise that the majority of dog owners are conscientious about picking up after their dogs, but there is a minority who are not. Observation by many allotment holders suggests that the issue most commonly occurs when dogs are off their leads and running off out of direct sight of their owners.

Dog walkers are requested to remember that the paths they are walking on are maintained by volunteers and dog poo makes this task unpleasant. Also the allotments are paid for by allotment holders who grow food on them. Dogs should not be allowed on the allotments (except for

allotment holders and their own allotments)



HATA has already put up signs to remind dog owners of their legal responsibilities. We hope to see a marked improvement, but if we don't, we will have to escalate matters and consider reporting people to West Suffolk Council. We sincerely hope it doesn't come to that.

Wildflower Meadow

In order to favour wild flowers over grasses, it is necessary to keep the nutrient levels of the meadow relatively low. This means removing the mowings. These will be composted in the bins at the bottom of the field and used as mulch for the community orchard. If you are able to help out on 2nd October – or indeed at any other time, we'd be very grateful.
