HUNDON SPORTS ASSOCIATION "THE ASTRO"

A while ago the software that operates the magnetic gate lock at the astro failed meaning that there has been an open gate "free vend" period. Unfortunately, this can't be a permanent thing. The terms of our insurance dictate that the pitch must be secured when not being used by authorised users. We have now installed a new system and, therefore, the magnetic lock will keep the gate locked again.

The temptation for some youngsters of course is to climb the fence and release the gate from inside. This is extremely dangerous as the fences are not designed for climbing on. They are high and flimsy at the top and a fall could result in serious injury. We are required to take measures to prevent climbing in this area and to that end an anti-climb grease will be applied to the perimeter fencing and gate above the level of normal reach. This substance is not harmful to skin although it is hard to get it off and it will ruin clothes. For those with youngsters of an age where they play out unsupervised can I ask that you speak to them and encourage them not to climb the astro fencing or gate.

It is possible to have a family membership of the Astro which costs £60 a year and allows use of the pitch at any times where it is not block booked for group activities. For further details please contact me on stewartalderman.sa@gmail.com.

We are not able to offer casual ad hoc use of the astro as it is simply not practical to administer this.

HGC NEWSLETTER APRIL 2022



ALLOTMENT FIELD UPDATE

Hundon Naturalists

Signs of spring in the air as we enjoy a bright and sunny spell for a few days.

The first gathering of the Hundon Naturalists took place on the afternoon of Sunday 20th March, the Spring Equinox. Small in number, but with good combined natural history knowledge, we spent an enjoyable couple of hours examining the habitats to be found around the allotment field: the hedges and associated trees, the running water and its banks, the wildflower meadow and the plots and plantings in between, to get an initial overview of what survey work we might do in more detail in future.



Despite the earliness of the season, over 40 species of plants were identified, including some harbingers of Spring: celandines, dog's mercury, cowslips and primroses, as well as the emergence of bee orchids.

Insects and birds are starting to be active. Signs of muntjac deer were seen and we shared tales of recent otter and kingfisher sightings.

Tree Safety Assessment



Lord Lieutenant's Torch Relay

This will be traveling through Brockley Green, Chimney Street and Hundon on the 18th May!

A symbolic torch will tour the county of Suffolk from Friday 13th May until Wednesday 1st June in order to herald the start of the Festival of Suffolk and the celebrations to mark HM the Queen's Platinum Jubilee. The torch will be carried by selected torch bearers and transported by rickshaw.

The torch provides light, symbolising a bright and prosperous future for the county. Its function is threefold:

- to herald the Festival of Suffolk
- to transmit a message of peace, unity and friendship to the people of Suffolk
- to showcase all that is good in Suffolk; places and people

Route / Timings

The torch will begin its journey on the county boundary at Brandon and then pass through 250 towns and villages, a distance of over 550 miles, before reaching its final destination at the Suffolk Show in Ipswich.

Torch Bearers

Communities across Suffolk are invited to nominate worthy individuals to carry the torch. These could include local heroes or notable characters chosen in recognition for their service to the community. The torch bearer will be transported by erickshaw which is equipped to carry passengers of all ages and abilities.

Hundon Community Primary School

As we, along with the rest of the country, finally find ourselves moving to the new 'living with COVID-19' phase of the pandemic, we wanted to share a little update with you on what the children have been up to at Hundon Community Primary School.

THE RECTOR'S RAMBLINGS: EASTER – THE GIFT REMAINS LONG AFTER THE CHOCOLATE HAS BEEN EATEN

Dear Friends,

On that very first Easter morning we are told that the grieving women went to the tomb to anoint the body of Jesus and were greeted with the astonishing words of the angel: "Why do you search for the Living One among the dead? He is not here. He has been raised up" (*Luke 24:5-6*).

This really was the most fantastic Good News! The confidence of Jesus in His Father was rewarded with the most astounding conquest over death and in the realisation of that very first Easter day. Easter is <u>the</u> time of great joy. Christ, our hope, is risen! Imagine the joy of the women, the apostles, the disciples, and of Mary, His Mother. The events of that first Easter had all of them ready to go around the world singing His glory and announcing His message of redemption and salvation to all who would hear.

We too are the children of God. Today this Easter victory is ours as well, if we embrace with faith the Easter miracle – Jesus, who had been put to death three days earlier, has now risen from the dead for you and for me. Every Easter Sunday we gather in our churches to celebrate Easter – with all that is happening in the world right now, we need this celebration now more than ever because we need to concentrate on the values, the faith, and the truth that Easter reveals to us. We need to know them, be convinced of them, and live by them. We should not allow the trials and challenges of this life destroy our hope in the life guaranteed to us by the Easter Good News.

While we may struggle to make this world respond to God's expectation for it in justice and peace, and while we struggle to banish oppression, hunger, disease, and war from the face of the earth, we must always nurture, through prayer and service to others, the hope we have through the Risen Christ for achieving his "new life". This is hope in the true and real promise of the Gospel, the possession of everlasting life in joy and peace with God. Let us ask the Lord to make us peacemakers in our homes and in our society.

Let us ask him to also make us true Christians who live the Gospel, who love the poor and care for the needy. Let us be people whose primary purpose is to build up the Kingdom of God, which is "justice, law and peace," so that the true meaning of Easter will be realised in the lives of humankind. On Easter Sunday the Risen Lord says to each of us, "Peace be with you". May we know and treasure that peace and love in its vision every day of our lives – after all his gift to us, eternal life, will remain long after even the best chocolate egg has been eaten.

CLARE CASTLE COUNTRY PARK MARCH 2022 ARTICLE

The Visitor Centre

The Park's Visitor Centre opened, in August 2021, in the old South Platform Waiting Room which has been refurbished and re-purposed. It is situated directly opposite the Platform One café and is open on Fridays, Saturdays and Sundays from 11 till 3. It is manned by our band of friendly volunteer stewards who are ready to assist visitors to the Park in whatever way they can.





The main purpose of the Centre is to be a source of information about the facilities and activities available in the Park. There are also a number of interpretive panels in the Centre that detail the history of the railway. There are over 20 free leaflets about the walks and trails available in and from the Park, together with Fact Sheets about the castle, railway and green spaces. There is also a leaflet explaining how the Park has tackled the issue of accessibility.

Complementing this offer are Clare Ancient House Museum booklets for sale about different aspects of Clare's history and built heritage, majoring on the castle site, the de Clare family, and connections with the royal family, Magna Carta and the Clare Reliquary Cross.

Also showing is a 20 minute 'Overview' film produced in 2021, some of it shot by drone, about the history of the site, the coming of the railway and the transition to a country park. This includes a number of voice-over memories of the site and the railway from local residents.

There are also a number of Park-themed items for purchase, from locally-sourced honey, duck food, postcards and cards depicting local scenes and children's items, through to craft wares from Clare-based artists and producers.

The final component is an N gauge (ie pretty small scale) working model railway of the Clare Station complex as it would have appeared in the mid-1950s when both steam and diesel were operating on the line. This model will be nearly 10 feet long and will be located in a bespoke cabinet that is already in situ. The model has been delayed by the serious ill-health of the main modeller. However, the buildings have been built, the rolling stock has been purchased and is now being weathered, and we are confident that it will be installed this summer.

The Visitor Centre is also the hub for Park-wide family activities like our orienteering trail, and the seasonal spotter trails (eg Christmas, Toy, Easter and Halloween). And we are currently training a small group of volunteers, under the auspices of Bury Tour Guides, to run accredited tours of the Park, Town and surrounding countryside.

Do come and visit us: our stewards are very welcoming and love to chat and tell their stories about the Park. For instance, one of our stewards remembers travelling on the last train to run on the line before Dr Beeching's axe fell in March 1967......

And finally we are planning to extend our opening days during the summer and **need more stewards**! If you are a 'people person' who likes talking to others, and can spare a minimum of 2 to 3 hours a month (you can do more if you want!), we would love to hear from you. 
