

Phew!!! Glad we weren't wearing these!!!

Our speaker in July was Jacqueline Norman who took us on a journey back to early Tudor fashion. We learnt that ladies of the court from 1485 would wear up to five main items of clothing each consisting of two or more layers. A sleeved linen shift, hooped underskirt, silk petticoat, a Kirtle that had many gathers, folds and jewels sewn on, and finally a heavy over gown. As well as additional items such as woollen stockings, a sleeve guard, placard, velvet partlet, white linen neckerchief, and a gable hood. They did not however wear knickers!! It took up to two hours to be dressed, which often meant being pinned & sewn into some of the items.

Girls from the age of two would have worn the same items of clothing, as well as bum rolls to give them curves, as they were at that age on the marriage market!





Jacqueline brought along replica clothing for us to see and feel the weight of. After suffering the recent heatwave and wearing as little as possible, we certainly didn't envy the Tudor ladies during the summer months!!

Suffolk launches £150,000 Match Funder scheme for community action on the climate emergency

A £150,000 fund has been opened to applications from not -for-profit organisations looking to deliver community-based carbon reduction projects in Suffolk.

The Suffolk Climate Action Community Match Fund will be provided by the Suffolk Public Sector Leaders group as part of its work to address the climate emergency. The new fund is available to charities, community interest companies, parish councils, voluntary groups and other not -for-profit organisations whose projects contribute to Suffolk's Climate Emergency Plan and support our vision for Suffolk to become carbon neutral by 2030.

The projects funded could include improving the energy efficiency of buildings, promoting walking and cycling, using sustainable/recycled materials, or raising awareness of climate change through events, among others.

The fund will support up to 50% of costs (up to a maximum of £10,000) for projects that can demonstrate support from others in the community in the form of contributions from multiple other sponsors for the remaining project costs. Community fundraising platforms online can be a great way of promoting a project and drawing in donations from sponsors; once sufficient community sponsorship has been raised, a full application to the Match Funder scheme can then be submitted.

Bury St Edmunds archives branch starts planning for the future

Suffolk County Council is looking to the future as it considers plans for its Suffolk Archives branch in Bury St Edmunds.

As part of long-term planning for the Suffolk Archives service, the county council is looking at options for either

remaining at its current location in Raingate Street or moving to the planned new Western Way Development.

Suffolk County Council will be working with users of the branch, depositors of archive documents, and other key local stakeholders to show what the archives service would be able to offer in the future at either Raingate Street or the Western Way development, as well as how they can input into the council's decision.

No decision has been made and any proposed options for the Bury St Edmunds Archives Branch will be considered by Suffolk County Council's Cabinet later in the year.

Extra funding agreed by Cabinet to fund new SEND places

Suffolk County Council's Cabinet has agreed an additional £15.9million to complete the funding for the creation of at least 879 specialist places for children and young people with special educational needs and disabilities.

This money marks the second phase of a £45million five-year project to deliver specialist provision for SEND students in Suffolk. These places include units attached to mainstream schools and three new special schools.

So far, 500 new places have opened across the county, with another 325 due to open between September 2022 and September 2024 under phase 1. The additional money will enable the completion of phase 2 of the project, and the creation of between 54 to 72 new places, depending on design and planning.

The new SEND places support the growing number of children and young people in Suffolk who need specialist help at school. Between September 2021 and May 2022 there have been 1,333 referrals for specialist placements for children currently in mainstream schools.

Plans for new SEND places under phase 3 will come before Cabinet from September. The newly-approved £15.9million includes £6million to complete phase 2, £4.6million to cover overspend and a grant from the Department for Education of £5.3million.

The special schools include Castle EAST, a new communication and interaction school in north Suffolk; a new social, emotional and mental health school in west Suffolk named Sir Peter Hall; and a communication and interaction school in south Suffolk, Woodbridge Road Academy.





Our meeting in June was held at Broxted Solar Farm kindly hosted by Charles Ryder. It was a perfect evening, neither too hot nor cold with the rain holding off until the very last minute. We enjoyed several of Charles's recommended wines, a selection of rosés and whites perfect for a beautiful summer evening. We were provided with a host of nibbles to lessen the impact of the alcohol imbibed all set up in a peaceful knoll with the sound of birdsong resonating in our ears.

All this following an informative tour of the farm where Charles explained to us the workings of the solar farm and the history of the farm itself, the prison and surrounding area. Charles explained the fantastic work carried out for nature conservancy including planting different plants and grasses, and creating a pond to attract a diversity of birds and animals, and a host of other measures. I have walked there many times, but I hadn't realised quite how lovely it is, one of the highest spots in Suffolk affording tremendous views.

To say that we enjoyed it would be an understatement! CLARE CASTLE COUNTRY PARK

JULY 2022 ARTICLE

And now for something (almost) completely different.....!

We are launching guided tours of Clare from the Park's Visitor Centre this month.

These bookable 90 minute tours encompass the main features of the Park together with key buildings across the Town before returning to the Park via Clare Priory.

Many local villages and towns are blessed with a rich history, particularly from the medieval period, and Clare is no exception. Three things make Clare particularly suitable for tours. Firstly, the town's heritage assets are within easy walking distance of each other. Secondly, it has over 130 listed buildings, 6 of them Grade I. And thirdly, its history connects with many events of national significance, thanks to the de Clares' status and links with the royal family.

Thus, in addition to the Anglo-Saxon period, the tour touches on the Domesday Book, Magna Carta, the Suffolk wool industry, the dissolution of the monasteries and the Battles of Hastings, Bannockburn and Bosworth Field. It also features Catherine of Aragon and such notables as Gilbert the Red and his wife Joan of Acre (daughter of Edward I), Lionel of Antwerp and Elizabeth de Burgh, as well as the fact that Kings John, Henry III, and Edwards I, II, III and IV all visited the Castle. We guarantee that even established locals will learn something or we will give them their money back!

Our guides have undergone a period of intensive training in the last four months, including lectures on local history given by three exceptionally well qualified Clare residents: Richard Smith, Emeritus Professor of Historical Geography and Demography at Cambridge University, his wife Dr Peggy Smith, and Anne Davies, a retired forensic scientist who has put her forensic skills to good use in researching local history. The whole programme was managed by Bury Tour Guides and funded by Clare Town Council under the 'Visit Clare' banner. The new guides, who have been recruited from the Park, the Ancient House Museum and Clare Walkers, are grateful to have learned from such an expert team, and are keen to put their newly-acquired knowledge to good use, so please do consider making up a party and coming along on one of the dates shown below.

The tours may be booked at www.clarecastlecountrypark.co.uk/towntours or at the Visitor Centre in the Park (open 11 am to 3 pm Friday to Sunday*).

Tours cost £5 for adults (under 18s free) and start from the Visitor Centre on the dates and at the times shown below.

We will go ahead come rain or shine, so please be ready for whatever the weather may throw at us! The tours are well worth doing on their own but are at just the right time to combine with lunch in the Park's Platform One café!


