This was the evening we sadly learned of the death of our dear Queen Elizabeth II, and as an avid member herself, I am sure she would have wished we carried on with our meeting.

Jan, our President, paid tribute to Her Majesty's service and dedication. We observed one minute's silence to reflect on her many years of faithful service to us all, although it was disappointing many members did not attend this wonderful get together.

Our speakers for the evening were Jill Brown and Fiona Gould from the Hedgehog Rescue centre in Hundon. We learned so much about our prickly friends. Jill explained how she, and helpers, are dedicated to care for and hopefully rehabilitate these beautiful creatures. The care they receive is fantastic, feeding regimes, cleaning and medication rounds keep the volunteers busy, their goal is to get the hedgehogs to an optimum weight to then be released back to the wild. It is estimated 1 million hedgehogs are left in the UK, so the hope is they will soon become a protected species.

Hedgehogs are partial to dried cat food and dog meat which are good foods to put out for them when their usual fare is scarce, (during periods of very hot, dry weather), and surprisingly there are more in towns than the countryside.

We were amazed to learn that hedgehogs are good climbers and can swim. They are born with white spines but within 24hrs their proper prickly spines start to grow, oh so cute. Any that have lost limbs that can be saved are sent to walled gardens to live their lives to the full in safety. We have to take care to check our gardens before we strim and check any piles of garden rubbish before we build bonfires to ensure no prickly friends are hiding.

We were introduced to Pip who was ready to be released the following day, apparently they have a character change when they are ready for release, Pip was somewhat grumpy, a bit hissy, but oh so beautiful. Good luck Pip on your adventures around Hundon.



## THE RECTOR'S RAMBLINGS: LAYING OUR CROWNS ASIDE – OCTOBER 2022

"But nothing that can be said can begin to take away the anguish and the pain of these moments. Grief is the price we pay for love... But the love will have been enough; all those impulses of love return to the love that made them. Even memory is not necessary for love." These were the words used by Queen Elizabeth II following the September 11<sup>th</sup> Terrorist attacks in America back in 2001 and they seem particularly poignant now as we mourn the death of our Queen.

Her death brings to an end a reign of more than 70 years, which has seen the transition of the United Kingdom from a Nation with an Empire to a Nation which has embraced the role of partnership within a Commonwealth of Nations. These nations, lands, and peoples with a diversity of culture, wealth, identity, and faith, all united together in a common vision. This common vision is focused on, reflected by, and directly linked to Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth, her sense of duty and her example of servant leadership.

Her own destiny changed with the abdication of her uncle King Edward VIII and the succession of her father King George VI. She sought to commit herself, nurtured by her Christian faith, on her 21st birthday to serve her Country and the then Empire. "I declare before you all that my whole life, whether it be long or short, shall be devoted to your service and the service of our great imperial family to which we all belong...God help me to make good my vow, and God bless all of you who are willing to share in it." She affirmed that vow through the Coronation rite when she was crowned Queen Elizabeth II on June 2, 1953, at age 27.

As King Charles III now ascends the throne and takes on the heavy burden which the being Head of State, Commonwealth, and indeed the Supreme Governor of the Church of England, perhaps it is right that we all make time to pause, both to give thanks for our late sovereign Lady, and to pray that Charles will carry forward all that was positive about his late mother's service.

Indeed, it is right that we should all reflect on how we live up to her example, how we can devote ourselves to a life of service and love, and how our own faith and commitment guides us in all that we do to make this world a better place.

One my favourite stories about the Queen that I have heard in these days following her death, comes from one of her chaplains, who tells of a time when The Queen said "How I wish the Lord would come back in my lifetime." To which her chaplain asked her "why?". Apparently, the Queen replied with quivering lips and her whole face lit with deep emotion as she replied, "I should so love to lay my crown at <u>His</u> feet.". That's the picture of heaven from Revelation 4:10-11, where we read that we will lay our crowns before God's throne and worship Him.

So, whilst our Queen has passed on to her eternal rest and passed the earthly crown to Charles, we are reminded that something continues, even beyond the earthly crowns and dynasties, and that is God. It is through Jesus Christ our heavenly King, that we, as his followers will always find, strength, new hope and fresh purpose, until we too receive our heavenly reward – that is eternal life.

## **HUNDON ALLOTMENT FIELD - UPDATE**

Autumn is definitely on its way. The hedges are covered in berries which will help birds and other creatures survive as winter draws in.

The Wildflower Meadow has been three quarters cut, with the final quarter left standing to support over-wintering insects in particular. This section will be cut in spring. We have completed the assessment for autumn maintenance activities such as trimming back hedges and these may well have started by the time the Herald drops through your letterbox. Although all the paths will be tidied up, we are deliberately leaving other areas to die back naturally.

We are establishing a small wildlife pond by the top allotment, next to the Queen Elizabeth Bug Hotel – you may want to go and have a look. We've already spotted several species of insect.

### Trees

We will be planting more trees over the winter and are working with our sponsors, The Sicon Foundation, to agree species and sites. We will be replacing the few fruit trees in the orchard that didn't survive the punishing summer, despite the best efforts of volunteers to water them. We intend to plant native species to fill gaps by the Chilton Brook, but also some attractive ornamental varieties around the field.
