#### FROM WEST SUFFOLK COUNCIL **VOTER ID**

The UK Government has introduced a requirement for voters to show photo ID when voting at a polling station at some elections. This new requirement will apply for the first time in England at the local elections on Thursday 4 May 2023.

#### Which forms of ID can I use to vote?

You may already have a form of photo ID that is acceptable. You can use any of the following:

- **Passport**
- Driving licence (including provisional license)
- Blue badge
- Certain concessionary travel cards
- Identity card with PASS mark (Proof of Age Standards Scheme)
- Biometric Immigration document
- Defence identity card
- Certain national identity cards

For more information on which forms of photo ID will be accepted, visit electoralcommission.org.uk/voterID or call their helpline on 0800 328 0280.

#### If you don't have an accepted form photo ID

If you don't already have an accepted form of photo ID, or you're not sure whether your photo ID still looks like you, you can apply for a free voter ID document, known as a Voter Authority Certificate. You can apply for this at voter-authority-certificate.service.gov.uk.

#### **Village Matters**

**Potholes** – Most potholes around the village have been reported. If you find a pothole that has not been reported, please use the Suffolk Highways reporting tool as detailed above.

**Thurlow Hunt** – In November there were 2 incidents where Thurlow Hunt entered the village causing damage to property and distress to animals and residents. The Parish Council have been in communication with Thurlow Hunt and received an apology regarding the incidents on the 3<sup>rd</sup> and 28<sup>th</sup> of November. The Parish Council are working with Thurlow Hunt to minimise any further disruptions which may be caused around the Parish of Hundon.

**Budget & Precept** – The budget and precept for 2023/2024 was finalised and agreed by the Parish Council at the January meeting. All financial paperwork can be found on the Parish Council website, along with information about applying for grants.

Finances – Cllr B O'Leary carried out a financial audit of payments. All was found to be in order.

**Football Club changing rooms** – This project continues. Power and water need to be disconnected from the site before the old changing rooms can be removed.

#### Government announcement on Council Tax support for vulnerable households - as at 22.12.22

Following public consultation, West Suffolk Council has already agreed that taxpayers in the Local Council Tax

Reduction Scheme will get a 100 per cent discount for the financial year for 2023/2024.

The Government announced on 19 December that there will be a £100m scheme to help councils offer Council Tax discounts to the most vulnerable households while ensuring that key services that people rely on, can continue to be delivered.

#### **RECTORS RAMBLINGS – FEBRUARY 2023** (COUNTDOWN TO EASTER)

Dear Friends,

Pancake Day, Lent and Holy Week are all part of the journey to Easter Day, the biggest Christian celebration of the year.

It is a time when lots of people make time to think carefully about their life. For Christians, this means trying to live God's way and remembering all that Jesus did.

#### Why we have Pancake Day

Pancake Day is also called Shrove Tuesday and is one last chance for a big party before Lent begins with Ash Wednesday the next day.

Long ago, Christians traditionally used up all the eggs and fat they had in store by making pancakes and feasting on them. This was because when Lent came, they would eat less food, or even fast (do without food sometimes) to help them focus on God and not on the things they wanted. This tradition has been passed down the generations.

Shrove Tuesday always falls 47 days before Easter, a date which changes every year. This year, we'll be eating our pancakes on 21st February, before Lent begins on 22nd February. With eggs, flour, milk and butter, pretty much anyone can join in with Pancake Day.

#### Why is Lent important?

Lent is a time of getting ready for Easter.

When Jesus was just getting started with his work, he went into the desert for 40 days to be all alone with God. He even went without food and prayed, and was tempted away from what God wanted him to do in all kinds of ways, but he resisted that temptation. You can read that story in the Bible: Matthew 4:1-11.

During Lent, Christians often do something different too, like praying every day or reading the Bible. This reminds us of Jesus' time in the desert to focus just on God and feel closer to him. The good news is that Sundays are still celebration days – so you can take a break from fasting! The last week of Lent is called Holy Week - during this time, the church remembers Jesus' death on a cross.

Even young children can take part in Lent. For example, giving up a sweet treat every day might remind children that we can live more simply.

#### Our churches in Lent

Churches may look quite different during Lent. You might notice the colour purple, or there may be very few decorations or flowers. This is because it's a time to concentrate on God and remember how Jesus gave up his life on a cross to save all of us.

Because Lent is a time to reflect, church music and songs will tend to be more reflective, and services won't ever include the word 'Alleluia' a very joyful word to express praise for God.

It's a big contrast when Easter Day arrives, when the colourful decorations come out, there's lots of celebration, 'Alleluias' and joyful music! Why not go along to a church service in Lent and play a game of spot-the-difference – how is it different to other services you have been to? Then go at Easter and play again! Talk about how each service feels and why they have these different moods.

You will be made very welcome at any of our services.





#### **ALLOTMENT FIELD UPDATE**

The weather remains cold and the ground on the allotment field has gone between rock hard and extremely muddy! This has proved a bit of a challenge for our recent phase of tree planting!

Our generous sponsors, the Sicon Foundation, delivered a load of bare root trees in December, that had to be stored as the ground was undiggable! Most of them have now been planted, but there are still a few outstanding.



As promised, in addition to our Jubilee tree, we have planted a number of ornamental trees by the paths at the top end of the field. These include Field Maple Queen Elizabeth and Mountain Ash Olympic Flame.

In our wildlife area at the bottom end of the field bordering the Chilton Brook, our volunteers have planted 2 new silver birch, 2 alders and a group of 3 black poplars – these are small as yet, but if we can keep them well watered this summer, hopefully they will grow strongly. We have also replaced the few fruit trees in the orchard that didn't survive the cruel, dry summer. Species included quince, medlar and mirabelle.

Our allotment holders are also grateful to Sicon for supplying nearly 40 fruit or native trees for planting on their allotments. We think that you will agree what was a fairly barren field will be unrecognisable in a few years.

The tree planting was planned partly to make the field an even more pleasant resource for the community, but also very much to improve the field for wildlife. The trees planted in the last 18 months will be registered as part of the Queen's Green Canopy, the tree planting initiative to celebrate the Platinum Jubilee. They will also form an important part of the nature recovery plan we are starting to develop for Hundon. HATA and the Parish Council will be sharing more about this initiative as plans develop over the next few months.

# CLARE CASTLE COUNTRY PARK PARISH MAGAZINE ARTICLE - FEB 2023

It may feel as though nature has been dormant since Christmas, but if you look closely there's plenty to see, touch and smell in the Park, even in the depths of winter.

Our standout trees of the moment are dogwood, its jewel red stems glowing among the greys and browns of late winter, and the ethereal silver birch with its ghostly white bark. You can't walk far without seeing catkins dangling from the trees. Derived from the Dutch word *katteken* meaning kitten, the flowers look like fluffy yellow kitten tails and provide a real shot of colour with the winter sun behind them.

January's hazel catkins are followed by this month's alder catkins. Alders grow close to the river where they thrive in the waterlogged ground. Most of Venice is built on piles made of alder trunks, which become rock hard in water, and they were probably used to support the wooden bridges that once crossed our rivers and streams.

Another tree to look out for in late winter is the old magnolia next to the station ticket office. The large pussy willow-like buds that set last year will continue to swell until spring, when water lily shaped flowers open for a few glorious weeks. The buds are like silk – touch them gently and it's like stroking a baby's head. Our magnolia is on the site of an Anglo Saxon burial ground, which is a mere 1200 or so years old. Magnolia trees themselves are far, far older: the species is so ancient that it pre-dates bees and relies on beetles for pollination.

Snowdrops are always a welcome sign that spring is around the corner. Walk up the Norman motte for swathes of white flowers – or save yourself a climb and enjoy the smaller patches of white opposite the café. As the snowdrop flowers die back we can expect the first wild primrose flowers, culminating in a sea of pale yellow along the railway walk in early spring.

Pushing through the undergrowth at this time of year are the few-flowered leeks which line the section of railway walk alongside the New Cut. Looking more like spring onions or wild garlic than leeks, these delicate plants have sea green leaves and pure white flowers which release a delicious, garlicky fragrance in springtime.

Some of our tiniest plants are best seen now when not competing with more vigorous spring and summer growth. The Park's plentiful supply of deadwood is home to a variety of mosses: a nuisance in your lawn, but a splash of vivid green in the grey days of winter, and vital shelter and food for minibeasts. Delicate ferns and ivy leaved toadflax can also be seen now on the shaded railway platform walls, which are well worth a closer look as you walk between the platforms.

Another woodland plant not always appreciated in our gardens is English ivy, which grows throughout the Park. The birds have already stripped the berries from other plants but leave ivy till last, so look closely and you'll see that much of it is still covered in small black berries. With each berry containing the same calories, gram for gram, as a Mars Bar, they are a feast for hungry birds when the winter cupboard is bare.

From food for the birds to food for humans, the Park is also home to a plant known as Alexanders. A relative of cow parsley it grows all over the motte, despite the best efforts of the Park's volunteers, and was highly valued historically as one of the few fresh plants available in January and February. It was also thought to cure scurvy and so popular with the seafarers of East Suffolk. We believe it was introduced by the Romans and can speculate that it may have been brought to Clare by the Anglo Saxons to provide food for the villagers. Local residents who've cooked it report that it is bland and uninspiring, but they are scurvy free!

Next time you're in the Park, why not take a closer look at the understated gems that late winter offers. It is amazing just how busy Mother Nature remains, even when she appears to be sleeping.
