For the past 20 years we have all been accustomed to our shop being brilliantly managed and led by Karen Snow. Karen became the paid shop manager on 1st July 2003 reporting to the Hundon Shop Committee, and since then has been the constant face of the village shop. In that time she has worked with and trained 100's of volunteers, worked with goodness only knows how many Chairmen of the committee, seen the shop through various stages of development including the major refit in 2016, and of course played a huge part in ensuring that the shop stayed open during those very uneasy early days of the pandemic and the first lockdown. When I became Chairman in 2017 it was clear to me that Karen was someone who was totally dedicated to ensuring that Hundon had a shop that had something for everyone and that was a vital hub for the village.

As a committee we knew that the time would come when Karen decided that it was the right time for her to retire from her commitments and she informed us a short while ago that now was that time. Happily, once she has finished as a paid employee, she has indicated that she will join our happy band of shop volunteers. Karen's final day as shop manager will be Friday 13th May.

There will be an opportunity for customers and volunteers past and present to join us to celebrate Karen's time running our shop. More details of this to follow in due course via the shop Facebook page and the shop notice board.

Annual Parish Meeting

The Annual Parish Meeting was held on 19th April 2023 at 7.30pm in the Social Club.

Reports were received from organisations around the village including HATA, Hundon Village Hall, Football Club, Rogeron Trust, Hundon Village Hall Committee and from Cllr B Bennett from Suffolk County Council and the West Suffolk District Councillors.

The Chairman's report highlighted the success of the Jubilee Celebrations and thanked those who volunteered and to those organisations which donated funds to the event.

Work completed over the year included reinstalling the Trig Point at Chimney Street, maintaining the hedges and verges, and continued consultation with Suffolk Highways around potholes, the crossroads sign and the collapsed bank at White Horse Cottage. The War Memorial will have its finishing touches in 2023/2024 with the completion of the resin bonded gravel.

The Parish Council continue to support local organisations and have awarded grants to: Hundon Post Office, Cricket club, Village website and Hundon Music Festival. Grants information is available via the Parish Council website.

With the Coronation of King Charles II, the Parish Council are planning a street party on Sunday 7th May 2023, with free music and food provided.

The Local elections will be held on 4th May 2023, and the Parish Council are pleased to announce that following an uncontested election, all seven councillors being returned for another 4 years.

The draft minutes will be available to read on the Parish Council website, but will not be adopted as a true record until April 2024.

Parish Council Meeting

Cllr B Bennett has offered some funding towards the replacement of the crossroads sign. This is low priority on the Suffolk Highways list and would be unlikely to be replaced by them until 2024/2025 and this date is subject to change.

Plans continue in support of the Coronation Street Party to be held on 7th May 2023.

Hundon Football Club continue with their plans for the building of new changing rooms.

The beacon post will be reinstalled after new engraving with the dates of the Jubilee and Coronation.

It was agreed to make a £250 donation to SARS, who provided defibrillator training in the village.

HUNDON WINE CLUB

At our last meeting we were able to sample some excellent Italian wines courtesy of James Aldridge of Corney and Barrow wine merchant in Newmarket. We started with a non-vintage Prosecco followed by three whites from Veneto and Umbria. The Tenuta was the stand out wine for me. We moved on to the reds starting with a light, fruity one from the slopes of Mount Etna! A red from Tenuta came next then our most expensive wine of the evening at over £50 per bottle, a Tuscan Brunello di Montalcino, but the undoubted star of the evening was a fantastic Amarone made from dried grapes in the Veneto region. It would have been a shame not to finish on a Vinsanto, Italy's lovely digestif wine. We certainly had a vinous tour of Italy and some really exceptional wines and James left us a happy man with a fistful of orders from our members. So if you are looking for some great wine from a traditional, renowned wine merchant, or happen to be in Newmarket, do consider this shop where you will find a wealth of wines and advice aplenty to help you make a selection. Something a supermarket will not have.

That'll last until you walk through the door. We're just the same as you - local people from in and around the area - and cannibalism died out round here a few years back.

"Years ago someone at a church was really awful to me"

That's really bad, and we're sorry you experienced that. Give us a chance to make that up to you.

"My kids will be too noisy"

Great, we love noisy children: each one created uniquely in the image of God. And anyway, the vicar can be guite noisy too!

"I can't come to church until I get my life together"

Church is HOW we get our lives together: a place for new beginnings and a place for belonging.

"Church is filled with a bunch of Hypocrites"

CORRECT! and there's plenty of room for more ... imperfect people are especially welcome.

"Is there some kind of Dress Code?"

Yes. The code is "wear some clothes". Come as you are.

"I'm not sure I believe everything you believe"

Absolutely FINE! But you can still belong and be part of a group of people journeying together to learn how to love. Doubters are always very welcome.

"If you knew what I've done, you wouldn't want me"

If you knew us, and what we've done, you wouldn't be worried. Forgiveness is at the heart of the Christian message. It's OK to not be OK.

"I'm not Church of England"

SO? Church is not about a religion - it's about relationship: relationship with God and relationship with each other. If you've got this far, may we suggest that you join us for an Evening Prayer Service? Come and see what's on offer, as well as the tea and slices of delicious cake afterwards!

BROXTED SOLAR COMMUNITY FUND FOR HUNDON APPLICATIONS FOR FUNDING – 2023

If your club or Organisation has a project requiring funding and which meets the following criteria please apply as detailed below. The closing date for applications is May 31st.

The main features of the Community Fund are summarised: -

- The total awarded will be £10,500. This will include a direct annual payment of £1,500 to Hundon School.
- The balance of £9,000 will be awarded to organisations or groups within the parish of Hundon.
- To receive an award from the Community Fund, an application must make a material change or create material benefit for the Community in and around Hundon, and may include revenue items as well as capital payments.
- The minimum award through the Community Fund will be £1,000 as any applicant must demonstrate 'material change' or 'material benefit' for the Community i.e. not narrowly focused or small in size or scope. Inevitably, not all applications will be successful.

The Community Fund is run by the Community Fund Group consisting of four members:

- The Chairman or Representative of the Parish Council currently Geoff Spooner. The Chairman of the Village Hall currently Chris Callow.
- One other representative of the Hundon Community with wide knowledge and experience of it the first such representative member being David Rowlinson.
- A representative of Navigator Land LLP, the owners of Broxted Estate (and hence landlords of Broxted Solar) the first such representative being Charles Ryder.

David Rowlinson acts as Chairman of the Community Fund Group and Charles Ryder/ Navigator Land LLP administers it.


Reminder:

Applications should be emailed to Charles Ryder at charles@gbfco.com by 31st May.

Applications should either be sent in the form of a brief but succinct note or by way of a brief business plan together with costings and where necessary, comparative quotes. Please note that all applications must be for projects which require £1,000 or more. During the two weeks following the deadline, the Community Fund Group will consider the applications, seeking where necessary, further information. (Sadly not all applications will be successful but such projects can apply in the following year.) The Group will then make recommendations to Broxted Solar as to which applications should be awarded funding and payments are anticipated to be made by early/mid July.

The Community Fund Group looks forward to receiving applications in the coming weeks. Among the many beneficiaries are the Primary School, Pre-school, All Saints Church, Village Hall Cinema, Village Fete, Football Club, Cricket Club, Allotment Club, Gardening Club, W.I., Hedgehog Rescue, War Memorial Refurbishment etc.

If you have an idea which you think might benefit the community why not apply - it could be on this list next year!



ALL SAINTS CHURCH PARISH GIVING SCHEME

A great many people enjoyed our Daffodil Cream Tea afternoon on Saturday 15th April and we raised the splendid total of £340 for church expenses. The church looked really lovely full of daffodils and colour.

But, how would you feel if the church had to close through lack of funding? That we could just not afford to keep it open because of the cost. Would you be happy for our lovely village to no longer have a church for baptisms, weddings and funerals and no more Carol services or Easter Services! It costs approximately £12,000 a year to keep our church open, £1000 a month, and that's before any repairs or improvements are undertaken. Churches receive no state support for repairs other than being able to reclaim VAT on specific items, it all has to be raised by the PCC through approaching Trusts or holding fund raising events. Before going any further, I must stress that there are no immediate plans to close the church and we want to keep it that way! But we do need help to secure its future for generations to come. All Saints is there for everyone - the Community Pantry is just one example of how it has helped, and continues to help, those of us who need a little extra support at this time and Revd Mark is always available for pastoral support whenever and wherever it is needed.

If you feel that Hundon would be a poorer place without the church, regardless of whether you attend church or not, then please could you consider signing up to the Parish Giving Scheme (PGS). With regular donations it helps churches to manage their finances with an improved cash flow. By giving just £5 a month, less than the cost of a couple of coffees at Starbucks, with Gift Aid would give an income to the church of £75 a year. The scheme also collects the Gift Aid from HMRC on donations if appropriate making donations go even further. We have a number of donors already and we are so, so grateful to them all. Donations can be monthly, half yearly or yearly, and one-off gifts are also possible – the choice is endless.

CLARE CASTLE COUNTRY PARK

Following last year's successful launch of the Suffolk Walking Festival, the Park is playing host to the Challenge Walk in this year's Festival. This is the 4 day 50-mile Wool Towns' Walk, being led jointly by Sudbury Ramblers and Clare Walkers. It is a circular walk that visits the West Suffolk Wool Towns of Clare, Sudbury, Hadleigh, Lavenham, Long Melford and Clare (again), starting in the Park on the morning of **Sunday 14 May and finishing on the afternoon of**

Wednesday 17th with a celebratory event in Clare Social Club. The guided Challenge Walk was fully booked within 24 hours of booking opening, but the walk itself is detailed at www.sudburyramblers.co.uk and can be walked in 8 manageable sections. It passes through some glorious Suffolk and North Essex countryside, including the Belchamps, Little Cornard, Assington, Boxford, Kersey, Lindsey, Glemsford and Cavendish. Do put your walking boots on and give it a go, maybe with a personal challenge to walk all the sections in a 12 month period.

Wednesday 17 May will be a busy day in the Park as, in addition to the Society of East Anglian Watercolourists' exhibition in the Old Goods Shed which is taking place from 4 to 21 May, it is holding a community awareness day, with organisations and charities across Clare showcasing their services. This day is aimed at residents of Clare and all the surrounding villages so please do come along and see what an amazing range of activities the town has to offer.

The idea of a Wool Towns' Walk was originally pitched to the Wool Towns' Association but was picked up by Sudbury Ramblers who scoped it and walked it last year as part of their Covid-delayed 50th anniversary celebrations. The walk has now been incorporated in Clare Walkers' new book "15 Walks around Clare: exploring West Suffolk and North Essex". The book is 68 pages long and includes the original 6 circular walks created in 2016, 4 short (2 mile) walks developed from the weekly Tuesday well-being walks, and longer linear 'compass' walks, north, east and west, with the fourth (south) being the Magna Carta Walk to Hedingham Castle created by Clare Ancient House Museum jointly with Castle Hedingham in celebration of the 800th anniversary of the sealing of Magna Carta in 2015. It also contains information about the two long-distance linear paths that include Clare, the Stour Valley Path and the Bury St Edmunds to Clare walk, both of which are marked on Ordnance Survey maps.

The book incorporates information about the town, including the history of the Castle and a 1,000 year timeline. It is on sale from the Visitor Centre in the Park (open Fridays, Saturdays and Sundays) and costs £8.99. It is also available on-line at www.clarewalks.co.uk

Stop Press!

With thanks to all those who visited the Park over the four days of Easter, we have had a record time, with some 480 people calling at the Visitor Centre to see the model railway and other facilities, and 245 children following our Easter trail. If you haven't visited yet (or even if you have), please do come and see us this spring.
