

Allotment Field update

Spring is very much in the air and there is a lot of activity on the allotment field. The orchard is blossoming – it should look fabulous as the trees mature – and we are getting more flowers in the wildflower meadow.

Plant Sale

Thanks to everyone who supported our plant sale, either by donating or buying plants. We were delighted to raise £500, which will be shared by HATA and Hundon Hedgehog Rescue.



Water-courses

A group of us, including members of the Parish Council, Rogeron Trust and HATA, had a very interesting meeting with experts from the Environment Agency and the Essex and Suffolk Rivers Trust. A walk around looked primarily at the water-courses around the allotment field, but included reviewing other green spaces in the centre of the village.

We were given advice about managing the water-courses, including the main ditch and the Chilton Brook, in a wildlife-friendly manner, and some thoughts on flooding mitigation. Some potential solutions to existing erosion issues were suggested and will be reviewed by the Rogeron Trust.

Andy and James gave us some useful contacts and have offered to try to be available in the future as we make progress with our Nature Recovery work.

RECTORS RAMBLINGS – JUNE 2023 (TRYING TO UNDERSTAND THE MYSTERY)

Dear Friends,

As we approach the mid-point of the year and the celebration of Trinity Sunday, it's a good time to reflect on the mystery of the Holy Trinity. It is a long held tradition that the Incumbent of a parish would always ask the newly ordained Curate to write or speak about the Trinity (it is a good test to see what they had learned at Theological College, and after all its what they were made to do when they were a lowly Curate many years ago) - but sadly for me, our new Curate - Dr Karen Smith, doesn't join us until next month, so it sadly lands back in my lap!

For Christians, the doctrine of the Holy Trinity is essential to our understanding of God and our faith. But what exactly is the Holy Trinity, and how do we make sense of it? Well at its core, the Holy Trinity is the belief that there is one God in three persons: the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. This belief is grounded in the teachings of Jesus himself, who spoke of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit as distinct but united in one divine being.

To understand the Holy Trinity, we must first recognise that God is a mystery beyond our full comprehension. Theologians have tried for millennia to explain the Trinity in various ways, but ultimately, it remains a mystery that we can only approach with awe and humility. One way to begin to grasp the Trinity is to reflect on the roles of the three persons of God. The Father is the creator and sustainer of all things, the Son is the redeemer who became human to save us, and the Holy Spirit is the source of life and power that animates the Church and guides us on our journey of faith.

Yet, these roles do not define the persons of the Trinity. The Father is not just a creator, the Son is not just a redeemer, and the Holy Spirit is not just a guide. Each person of the Trinity is fully God and has an equal share in the divine nature.

So why is the doctrine of the Holy Trinity so important? For one, it affirms that God is love, and love requires a relationship. The Father, Son, and Holy Spirit are in an eternal and loving relationship with one another, and we are invited to share in that relationship through our faith in Jesus Christ.

Furthermore, the Holy Trinity teaches us that God is both transcendent and immanent. God is beyond us and yet present to us in a way that is personal and intimate. We can approach God as the one who created us, as the one who saves us, and as the one who empowers us to live a life of faith.

In the end, the Holy Trinity invites us to deepen our relationship with God and with one another. As we reflect on the mystery of the Holy Trinity, let us be reminded of the unity and diversity of God's creation and the call to love and serve one another as we journey together towards our shared hope and destiny.

May the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, the love of God, and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with us all.




