

#### WINE CLUB NEWS

Our July meeting was a presentation by Jake Bennett-Day from Vino Gusto. We sampled eight different wines including four Greek ones, of which Jake has a lovely selection in his shop from which to choose.

Starting with a rarely encountered German Sekt, a sparkling wine made from the Riesling grape which was fresh, fruity and a lovely starter for the evening. Following on to a Vinho Verde, a slightly sparkling wine from northern Portugal. At last we ploughed into the Greek wines with two whites, a Malagousia and an Assyrtiko. The first red was from Manolosakis estate, the second made from probably Greece's most famous grape, Xinomavro. All quite a mouthful both in the pronunciation and the wines themselves! We finished off with a couple of old favourites, a Rioja and an Aussie Shiraz with the amazing name of 'Blood and Chocolate'!

The wines were well received, but with some reservations, and Jake's knowledge and enthusiasm, plus his history in the wine trade for such a young man were a joy to see.

We managed to polish off the remainder of the wines plus some extras to go with our late supper which was prepared by our members Alan and Jill.

- **31 August** Nick Watson of Cooper's Croft up at Ashfield Green, our local vigneron, he will be showcasing his wine along with a colleague.
- 28 September Will be the wine club social event in the hall.
- **26 October** Charles Eaton, a long-standing presenter of ours suggesting wines for Christmas.

Also in October the more intrepid of us will be on our now annual overseas trip to Portugal. Trying out some fabulous ports at quintas in Porto before travelling up to the beautiful Douro hills to help reduce the annual production of the region.

We meet every last Thursday of the month at 8:00 in the village Hall.

## IMPORTANT NOTICE: COMMUNITY EMERGENCY PLAN

West Suffolk Council has advised all Parish Councils to form a Community Emergency Plan (CEP) in case of a natural/unforeseen disaster, such as wildfires, flooding, heavy snowfall, loss of power for prolonged periods due to extreme winds, a chemical spillage, or even another pandemic. We have all seen these natural disasters happen in other parts of the country over the last few years, whole communities being devastated by flood waters, wildfires and gale damage.

We all pray that Hundon is never affected by such a disaster, but in this time of global warming the threats are becoming more likely. The Parish Council think it is important that we have a CEP in place in case of such a natural disaster or unforeseen incident. We are asking for anyone living in Hundon with special skills, such as a doctor, nurse, plumber, electrician, builder, vet, or carer, all people whose skills could be vital in such a disaster, to be part of our CEP by giving us a contact number that we could call in such an emergency.

We are also looking for anyone with special equipment, such as a tractor and plough, to create fire breaks, a snowplough, to clear snowdrifts so emergency services can attend to resident's needs, a chainsaw to clear fallen trees, anyone with a generator?

The more contacts we have logged with useful equipment the easier it would make the emergency tasks ahead of us. It would save us so much time trying to find someone within the village or locally with equipment, or a specialist skill, if we had their contact details on record, we all know that in times of emergency every minute counts, and could potentially save lives.

We also think it would be a good idea to have a list of vulnerable residents, so in an emergency we could check on these people, make sure they are OK and help them if needed. The list would be confidential to the CEP organizers, so if you, a relative, a neighbour or friend, is elderly, disabled or have other special needs please contact us so we can add your details to our list in case of an emergency.

If you would be prepared to give us your contact details and help us put together a Community Emergency Plan, we would be very grateful. Hundon residents were marvellous in the COVID pandemic, coming together and looking out for each other, especially the Hundon Little Helpers, they really were a lifeline for some residents. We as a community should be very proud of the way we pulled together and supported one another. If you can help in any way, please contact myself or the Parish Clerk on the details below.

Hopefully we will never need your services, but it will be reassuring to know we have a plan and your details if needed.

#### **HUNDON VILLAGE SHOP AND POST OFFICE**

At the beginning of August, the shop received an unannounced surprise visit from a local authority food safety officer. On these visits the local authority has a thorough look at the premises looking at hygiene, food safety records, date control procedures, temperature control, segregation, handwashing provision and food allergy information. At the end of a visit the premises will be awarded a food safety rating ranging from zero to five. We are delighted to report that the shop received the top rating of five with the officer commenting that she wished that all the premises that she visited showed the same diligence and focus to food safety processes as we did.

With so many cash machines being removed, especially in rural areas, did you know that you can withdraw cash from all major banks and building societies at our Post Office. The amount that you can withdraw will be the same as your daily limit from a cash machine.

#### We are looking for a new Treasurer to join the shop committee.

After 17 years of diligent and committed work as the shop's treasurer Bernard Beer has informed the committee that the time has come for him to stand down. We are therefore now looking for a new treasurer to take over from Bernard. The treasurer pays supplier invoices, collates income and outgoings information, and prepares the end of year accounts for the independent accountant to audit. A full handover with Bernard and any training required will be provided. #### **HUNDON WI MEETING – 10<sup>th</sup> August**

Our meeting last month was a visit to Coopers Croft Vineyard, where Nick Watson, the owner, shared his knowledge, passion, and incredible journey with us; as well as a glass or two of his delicious award-winning wines. Well, it would have been rude not too have tried them!!

Having a background, and degree, in agriculture, Nick knows a thing or two about soil and crop growing, but why stop there? He decided he would like to set up a small vineyard, as a hobby.

After spending 2 years searching for a suitable property with land which had to be south facing and have a slope, Nick and his young family moved to Ashfield Green in 2011. With much blood, sweat, and a no doubt a few tears, he set about clearing and preparing the acre of land, eventually planting 1000 vines. He chose two grape varieties, Bacchus as a white and Pinot Noir as a Rosé. Fast forward to 2018 and the production of 500 bottles of wine, Coopers Croft Vineyard was firmly established. With some 2000 bottles now being produced, there are plans to expand further with the planting of a new hybrid grape variety.

Winning Bronze for their Bacchus at the Wine GB East competition in 2021 they went on to win Gold in 2022 and have won Gold again this year. The Pinot Noir fizz, which has just been bottled, also won Gold, with the Pinot Noir Rosé winning silver.

If you haven't tried British wines yet, for one reason or another, I think you'll be pleasantly surprised, as verified by the WI ladies who were queuing up to buy a bottle or two at the end of a most enjoyable evening. Cheers!!

# CURATE'S CHRONICLES – SEPTEMBER 2023 (BRINGING IN THE HARVEST)

We spend most of our lives going out or staying in and keeping ourselves busy and occupied whether its sitting and watching TV or listening to the radio or going out and about shopping and getting jobs done. We also travel around in different ways too, some of us walk, some go by car or bus or train to places. But what do you notice when you're getting on with your daily routine? And do you notice as much as you think?

I've just moved to the Stour Valley and, from wandering around the streets looking at everything with 'fresh eyes' and chatting to people, it seems there is lots going on! Plenty of very old and some very new buildings, some newly opened and some closed-down businesses and people from all walks of life, some wealthy and some struggling to make ends meet. But the one thing I've really noticed is that we are surrounded by such beauty: the fields, trees, parks and green spaces.

When you slow-down running from A to B you begin to take more notice of how buildings, streets and nature look and what might be going on in people's lives. This is a bit like harvest, if harvest was something that happened instantaneously, we'd probably be overrun with food and resources, and everything would be really overgrown. However, harvest is something which takes time to grow and flourish, it takes significant time, labour, and effort for farmers to grow their crops and take care of them, so they are edible for us to eventually eat.

Harvest comes at such a beautiful time of the year, as we enter into autumn. If we slow down and take our time to be with God in these moments, then we start to notice the change of the colours on the trees, and the changes surrounding us in the villages and towns we live in. We begin to see the beautiful blend of red, orange, green and yellow on the trees and the carpet of leaves below.

However, harvest is also a time of hardship for some, the temperature begins to drop and some people who live just a few streets away from us, will be wondering how an earth are they going to be able to feed themselves or their family and heat their home.

So 'harvest' isn't something that should just happen once a year, we can serve others anytime with our hearts, whether that's physically through giving food or mentally by words of wisdom or just listening to what others have to say - you never know what burden someone is carrying so we need to be gracious. As we go about our daily lives, let us think about the ways we can serve God through harvesting other people's lives not just our own and let us be thankful for the material and spiritual gifts God has blessed us with. Amen





#### Clare Liaison and Support Project (C.L.A.S.P.) Registered Charity No 1029710

**CLASP** was founded in Clare in 1984 to serve those in Clare and the surrounding villages who might be in need of help and support, as well as being involved in a number of worthwhile local activities. **CLASP operates:** 

#### SENIOR CITIZENS CENTRE

Every Wednesday from 10.30 to 3.00pm. in the Clare Old School Community Centre. Morning coffee, a three course lunch, and afternoon tea are provided for a small charge for as many as 30 clients, who can participate in table games and other activities. The **CLASP minibus** service picks up clients with transport problems from Clare and some nearby villages. *Contact Sue Packer on 07561 115158*.

#### **CAR AID**

A pool of about 20 volunteer drivers take "clients" needing transport from their homes in the Clare area to hospitals, doctors, dentists or other medical practices. *This is free of charge*, but many clients make voluntary contributions to petrol costs.

#### The CLASP MINIBUS

Operated by qualified volunteer drivers, is available for hire at very modest rates for use by local organisations. It also collects "clients "from Clare to take shopping to **Supermarkets in Haverhill**, generally on a Tuesday, for which a small charge is made. #### **FUND-RAISING EVENTS**

Are also organised by **CLASP**, principally Table Sales in the Clare Town Hall seven to eight times per year, not only to help fund the activities mentioned above, but also to make donations to other local worthwhile causes, such as recently committing to the part funding of a defibrillator for use in Clare.

**CLASP** is totally managed and run by **VOLUNTEERS** and is always delighted to welcome new people to assist with its activities.

Despite having existed in Clare for many years it is surprising how many residents of Clare and the surrounding area seem to be unaware of the services **CLASP** provides, and it is hoped that viewing this article will encourage local residents to take advantage of and/or assist with **CLASP**'s charitable work.

#### CLARE CASTLE COUNTRY PARK: ARTICLE FOR SEPTEMBER PUBLICATION

#### The Expanding Park

The *Queen's Green Canopy* was a UK-wide tree planting initiative created to mark the late Queen's Platinum Jubilee in 2022 by inviting people to 'plant a tree for the Jubilee'. It provided the catalyst for David Byford, a local landowner, to gift 5 acres of land to the Park. The Byford family have a history of benefaction; they gifted the Ancient House in the High Street to the Town in the 1930s to stop it being dismantled and shipped to America!

The site is situated to the west of the existing Park, on the far side of the Ashen Road, with access close to the Ashen Road bridge. The land, which previously formed about half of a large arable field, was last year transferred to Clare Town Council. The Council owns the Park, but its management is vested in Clare Castle Country Park Trust which has assumed responsibility for the development and maintenance of the new land.

The first task was to obtain planning permission for change of use

from agricultural to amenity woodland. This done, the next task was to plant some trees! A report was commissioned from Suffolk Wildlife Trust on how best to develop the site as a woodland area that would be a haven for wildlife. In order to stop weed growth the whole area was seeded with grass and some 1400 whips planted across the site. This year both the whips and the grass have been growing well, the southern boundary has been fenced and rides have been cut so that people can walk through the site. All this has been overseen by Neil Bagshaw, the trustee responsible for green spaces. The most significant development for the future has been the planned introduction of 37 specimen native trees later this year. The purchase of these trees has been funded by patrons and supporters of the Park, under the management of Geoffrey Bray, former Chairman of the Park Trust. The intention is that these trees will form the top level canopy, with the whips providing the under-storey. The trees involved are oak (11), hornbeam (4), small-leaved lime (6), silver birch (6), alder (3) and black poplar (7). The black poplar trees, native only to this part of the UK, have already been planted. They were donated by the Dedham Vale and Stour Valley Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty. The remaining trees will be planted this autumn. Parts of the site are prone to winter flooding, though they drain quickly. The black poplar, silver birch and alder have been chosen for these areas as they are tolerant of wet soil.

Most of the green space maintenance in the Park is undertaken by volunteers and this initiative has added quite a bit to their work schedules as the maintenance in the early years will be quite intensive. The specimen trees will need watering every fortnight in summer, the soil around them will need clearing, paths will need to be maintained, and the grass cut in a way that avoids damaging the whips.

Of course, this whole project is a long-term investment in the community's future and it is succeeding generations that will reap the benefit of David Byford's generosity and the hard work involved in establishing the site. Overall, it is safe to say that this project captures the essence and spirit of the Queen's Green Canopy, and in my view is a life-affirming tribute to the generosity of spirit of everyone who has been involved.




